

Starters, Completers and Early Leavers Per Month


- o Most months, between 600 and 800 beneficiaries were started on dossier 041007ES.
- The number of beneficiaries completing each month steadily increased to approximately 500 in August 2006. The number of completers then dramatically increased during the last seven months of the project.

Reasons for Early Leavers

• Of the 3037 beneficiaries who left the project early, 57% (1731) transferred to a non-PS Plus establishment.

- o 13% (383) of early leavers decided not to continue on the project.
- o 18 beneficiaries left the project for health reasons.








Beneficiaries Started On PS Plus

- The ethnic origin of 26 beneficiaries was not known.





 $\circ~$ The average (mode) age group is 31 - 40 years old.



• 3% (477) of the beneficiaries on 041007ES were classified as being disabled.



Needs of the Beneficiaries Started on 041007ES




- Over 90% of the beneficiaries on dossier 041007ES needed help with employment issues.
- Nearly 90% of the beneficiaries on dossier 041007ES needed help with education.
- Over 50% of the beneficiaries on dossier 041007ES needed help with housing and almost 50% needed help with drugs issues.


Beneficiary Background

- Nearly 8000 of the beneficiaries on 041007ES were ex-offenders. 0
- Over 6500 of the beneficiaries on 041007ES were on the labour market. 0
- Over 4000 of the beneficiaries on 041007ES had a drug or alcohol problem 0

- o 8% (1237) of the beneficiaries on dossier 041007ES were classed as having no fixed abode on starting the project.
- Of these, 182 beneficiaries had an accommodation outcome secured. A further 1271 beneficiaries who were not classified as having no fixed abode also gained an accommodation outcome.



o 12261 Soft outcomes were gained by beneficiaries on 041007ES.


- 1587 beneficiaries gained IAG assistance.



- o 720 beneficiaries passed a course in computing.




