


- o Most months, between 100 and 200 beneficiaries were started on dossier 041009ES.
- The number of beneficiaries completing each month steadily increased to approximately 150 in August 2006. The number of completers then dramatically increased during the last seven months of the project.

- 3383 beneficiaries were started on dossier 041009ES.
- o Of these, 2817 completed the project when their sentence expired and 566 left the project early.

Reasons for Early Leavers

• Of the 566 beneficiaries who left the project early, 52% (294) transferred to a non-PS Plus establishment.

o 7% (42) of early leavers decided not to continue on the project.

• For 33% (56) of the beneficiaries who left early, the beneficiary was discharged from court/bailed.








Beneficiaries Started On PS Plus

- The ethnic origin of 8 beneficiaries was not known.




- o 84% (2835) of the beneficiaries started on dossier 041009ES were from United Kingdom.



Disabled Beneficiaries




o 5% (159) of the beneficiaries on 041009ES project were classified as being disabled.

Needs of the Beneficiaries Started on 041009ES


- Over 90% of the beneficiaries on dossier 041009ES needed help with education and over 90% needed help with employment issues.
- Over 50% of the beneficiaries on 041009ES needed help with housing and over 50% needed help with drugs issues.
- o 40% of the beneficiaries on 041009ES needed help with health issues.






- $\circ~$ Over 2200 of the beneficiaries on dossier 041009ES were ex-offenders.
- o Approximately 1500 of the beneficiaries on dossier 041009ES had a drug or alcohol problem.
- Nearly 400 of the beneficiaries on dossier 041009ES were lone parents.

- o 10% (340) of the beneficiaries on dossier 041009ES were classed as having No Fixed Abode on starting the project.
- Of these, 104 beneficiaries had an accommodation outcome secured. A further 684 beneficiaries who were not classified as having no fixed abode also gained an accommodation outcome.



o 5977 Soft outcomes were gained by beneficiaries on 041009ES.


- o 951 beneficiaries gained IAG assistance.

- o Where known, only 6 exams were failed.



- o 457 beneficiaries passed a course in computing.




