

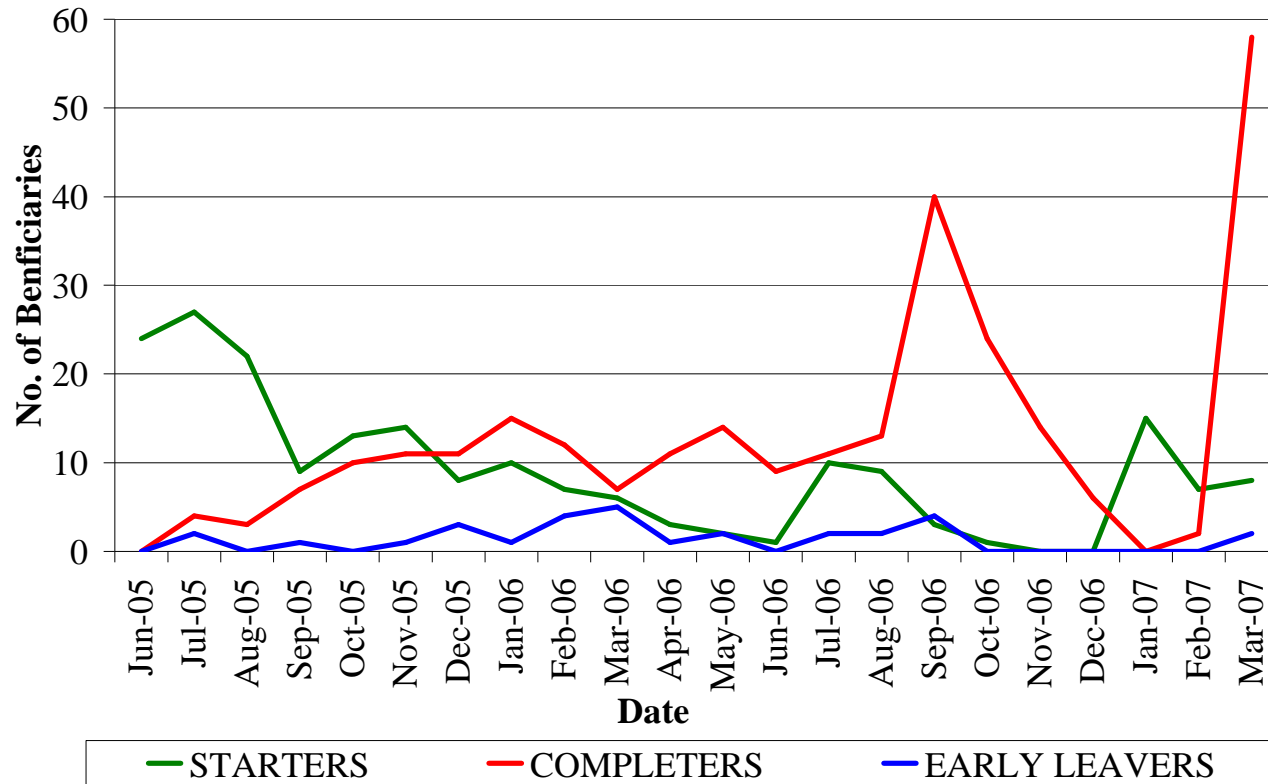

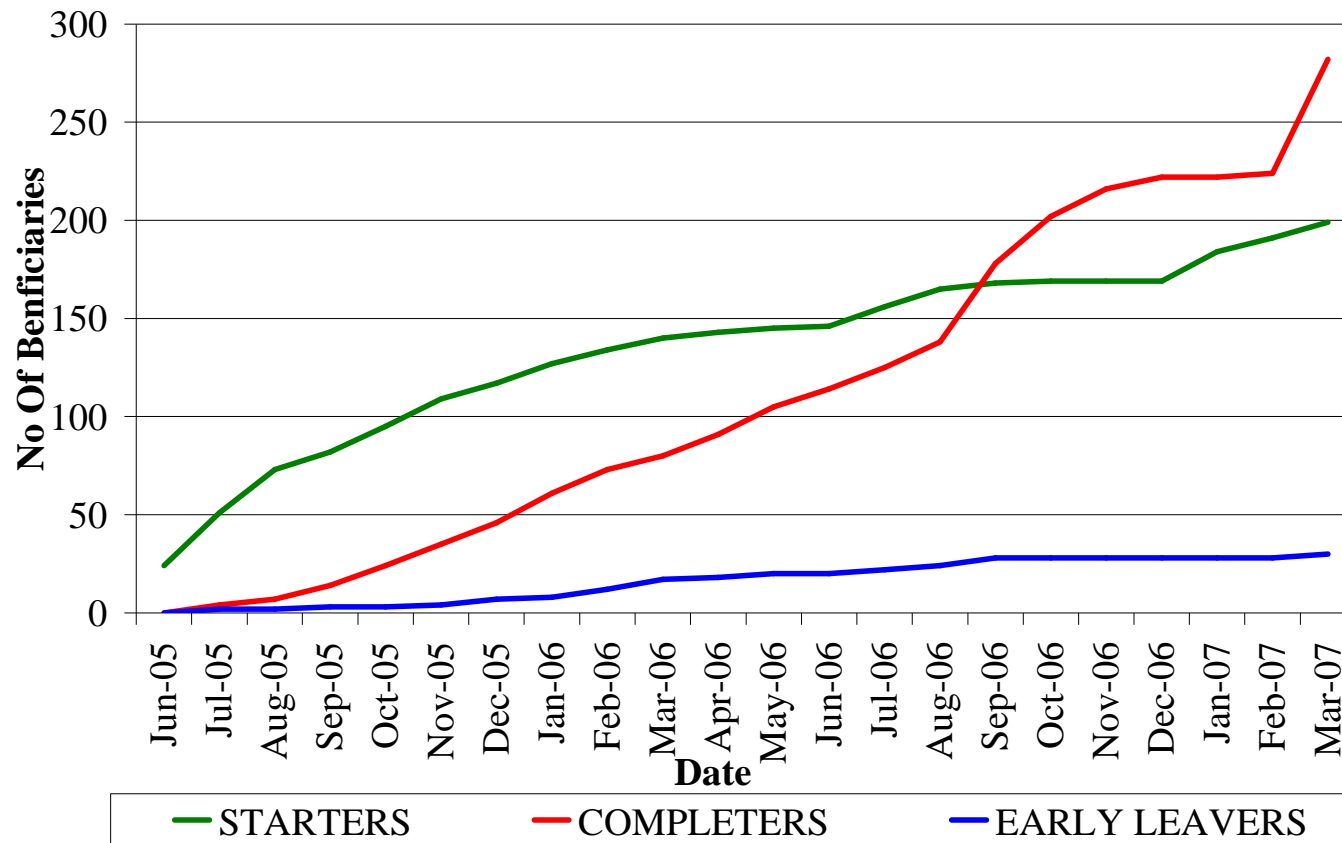

Starters, Completers and Early Leavers Per Month



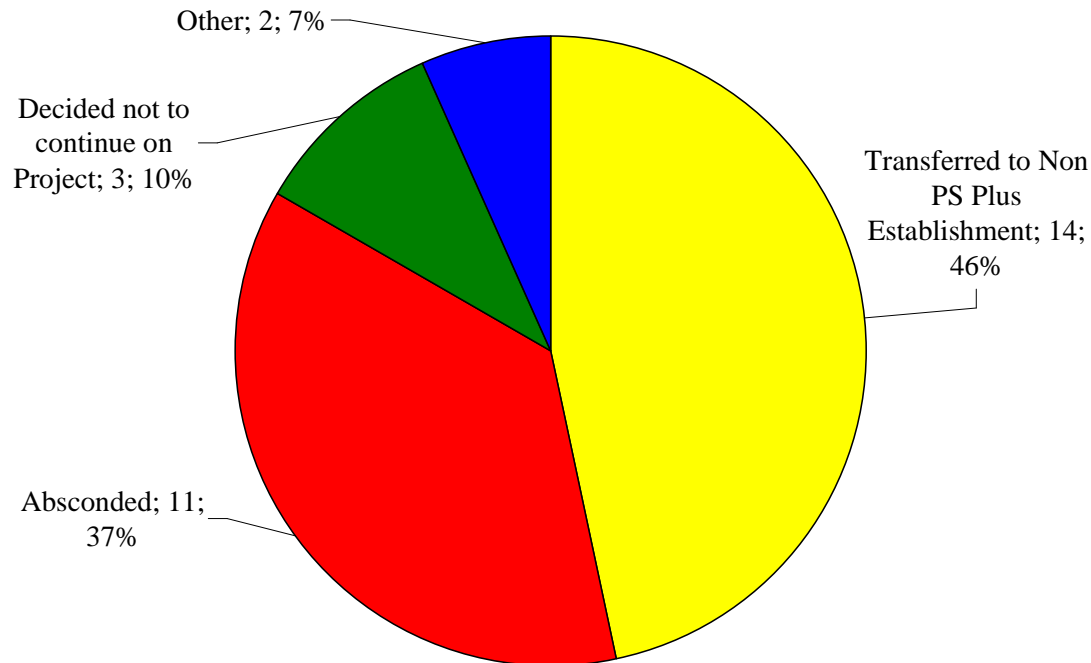
- Most months, Askham Grange started less than 10 beneficiaries on the PS Plus 2 project.
- No more than 15 beneficiaries were completing the PS plus 2 project per month, apart from in September and October 2006, and January 2007 when project closure was expected.

Cumulative Starters, Completers and Early Leavers



- Nearly 200 beneficiaries were started on PS Plus 2 in Askham Grange.
- Approximately 310 beneficiaries finished in Askham Grange – 282 completed the project and 30 left the project early.

Reasons for Early Leavers

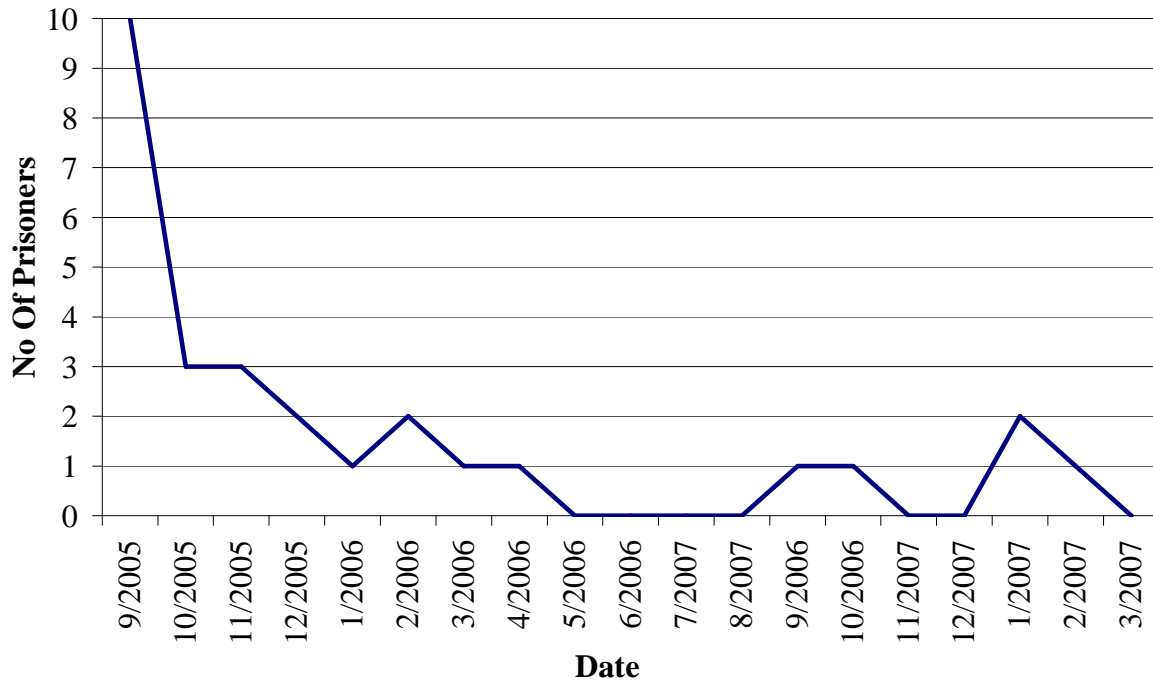


Other reasons given for beneficiaries leaving the project early:

- Of the 30 early leavers, 14 transferred to a Non-PS Plus establishment.
- 37% (11) absconded from prison.

Non-Starters Per Month



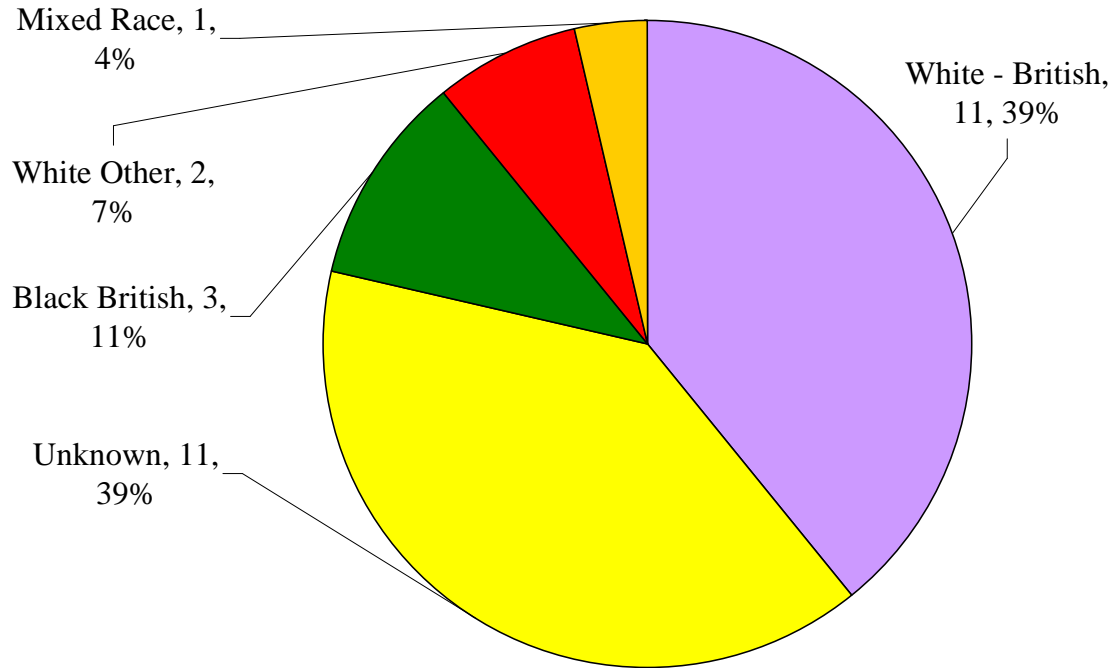

- Most months, less than 3 prisoners were seen and deemed unsuitable for the project.
- In total, nearly 30 prisoners were not started on the PS Plus 2 project in Askham Grange.
- 9 of the prisoners not started in Askham Grange did not meet the required eligibility criteria and 4 prisoners transferred before being started on the project (1 transferred before the assessment entered and 3 to a non-PS Plus establishment).

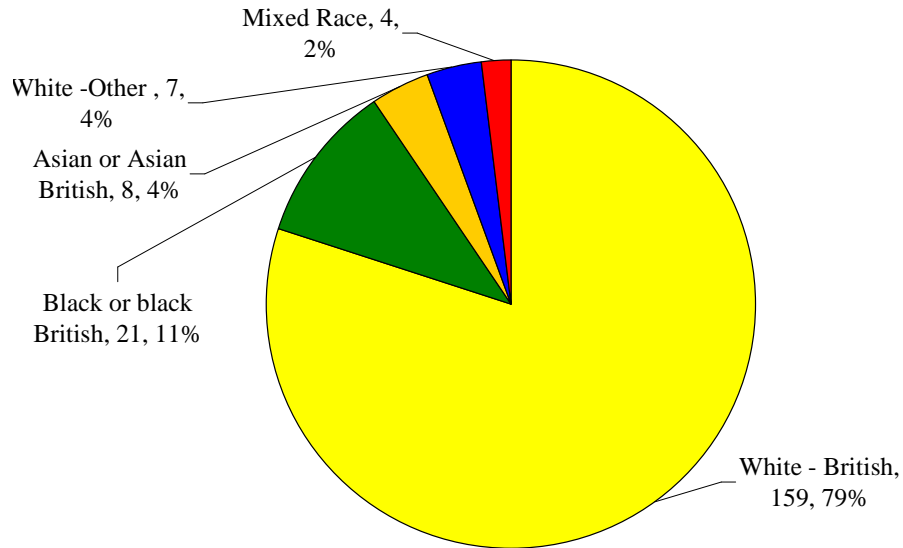

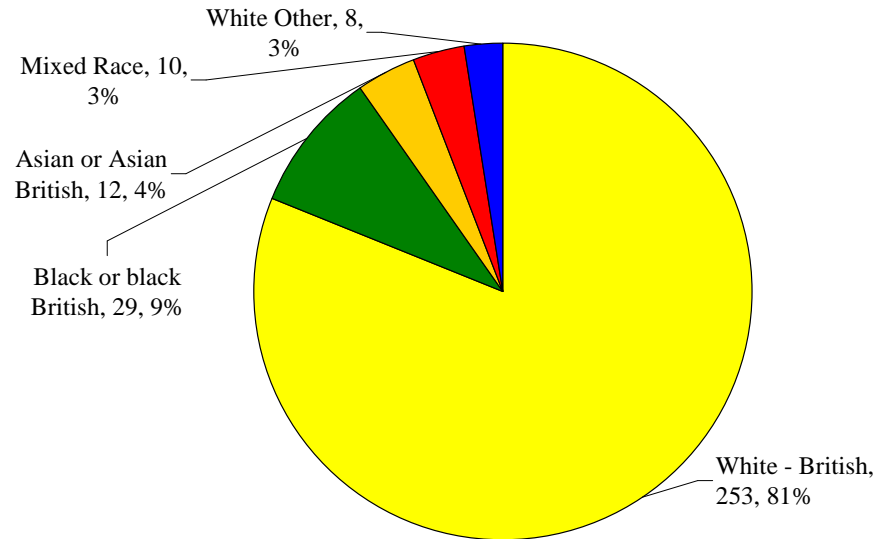
- The majority of the prisoners not started on the PS Plus project were Ethnic Origin: White-British (39%) and nationality: United Kingdom (39%).
- The ethnic origin for 2 in 5 and the nationality of 1 in 3 of the prisoners not started was unknown.
- Ethnic minorities account for 22% (6 prisoners) of the prisoners not started.

- 79% (159) of the beneficiaries who started and 81% (253) of the beneficiaries who finished in Askham Grange were White-British.
- 21% (40) of the beneficiaries who started and 19% (59) of the beneficiaries who finished in Askham Grange were from ethnic minorities.

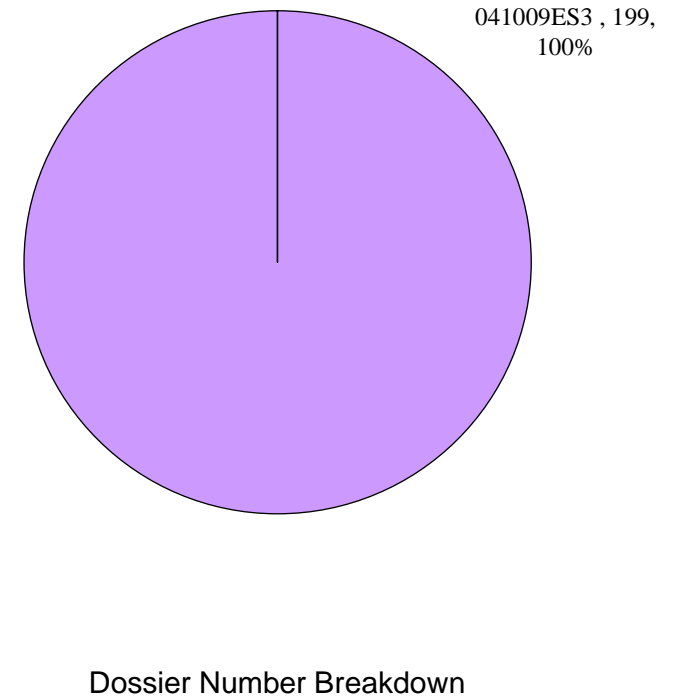
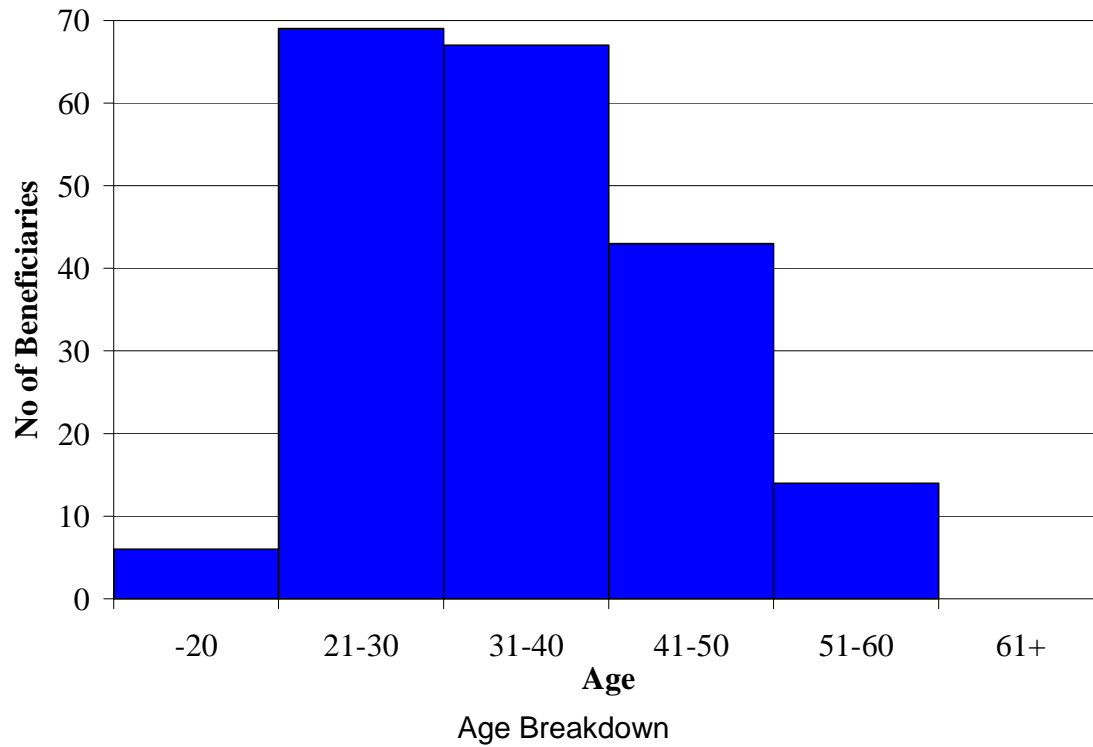

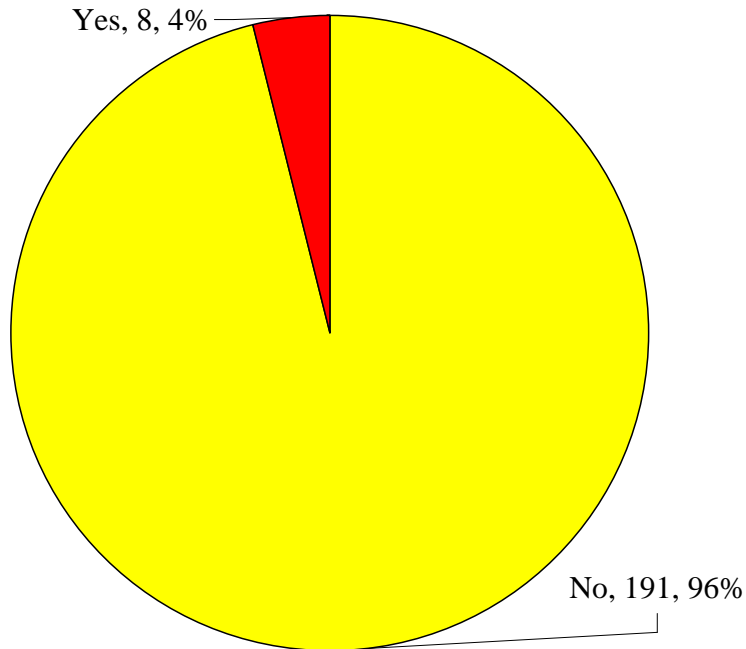
- 93% (185) of the beneficiaries started in Askham Grange stated that their nationality is United Kingdom, British or English.
- 95% (295) of the beneficiaries who finished in Askham Grange stated that their nationality is United Kingdom, British or English.
- The nationalities of 7 of the beneficiaries started in Askham Grange and 7 of the beneficiaries that finished in Askham Grange are unknown.

Age and Dossier Number of Beneficiaries on Starting PS Plus 2

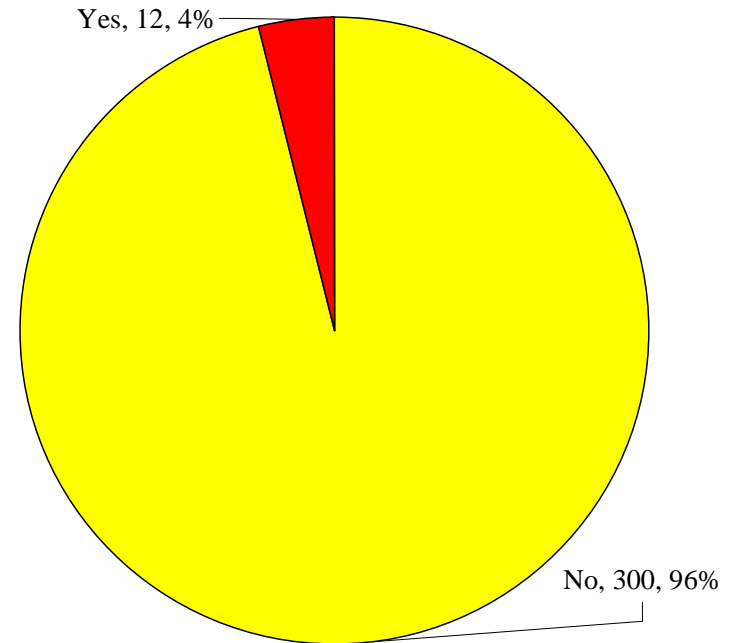


- The average (mean) age of the beneficiaries started in Askham Grange is 34 years and 11 months. The average (mode) age group is 21 – 30 years old.
- 100% (199) of the beneficiaries are in the ESF Group 041009ES3 (female beneficiaries).

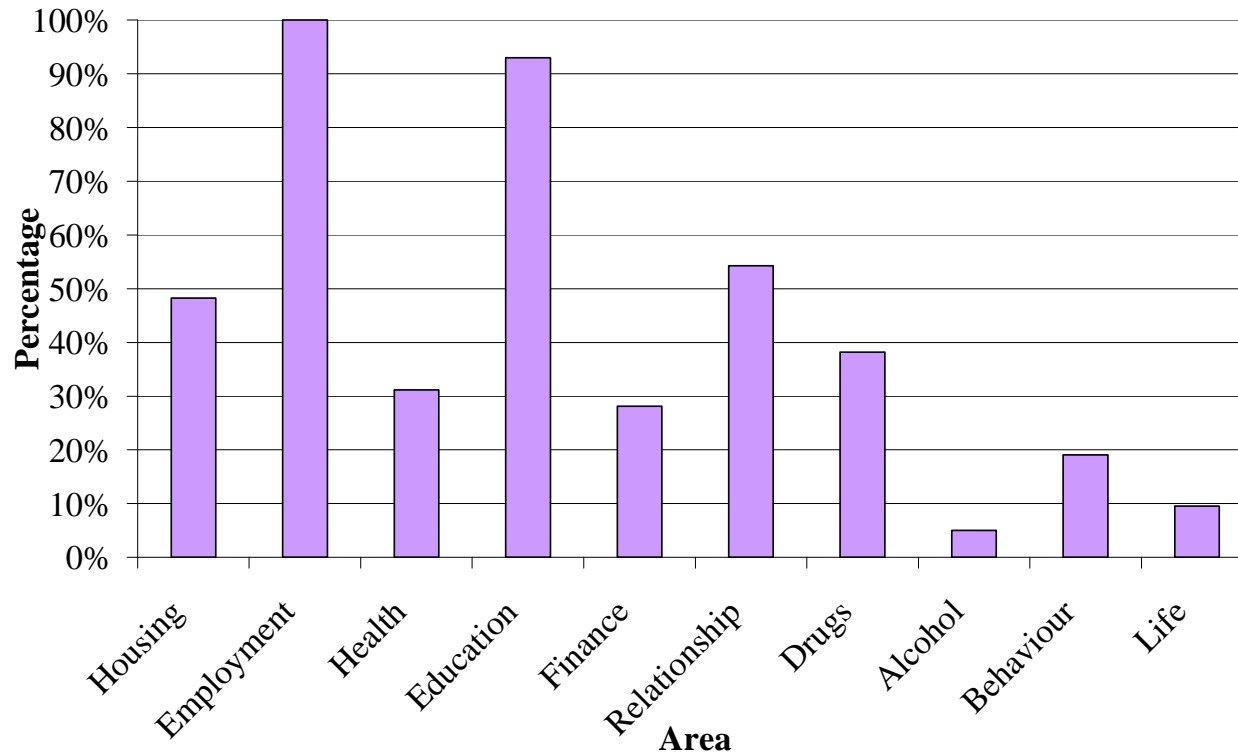
Beneficiaries Starting in Askham Grange



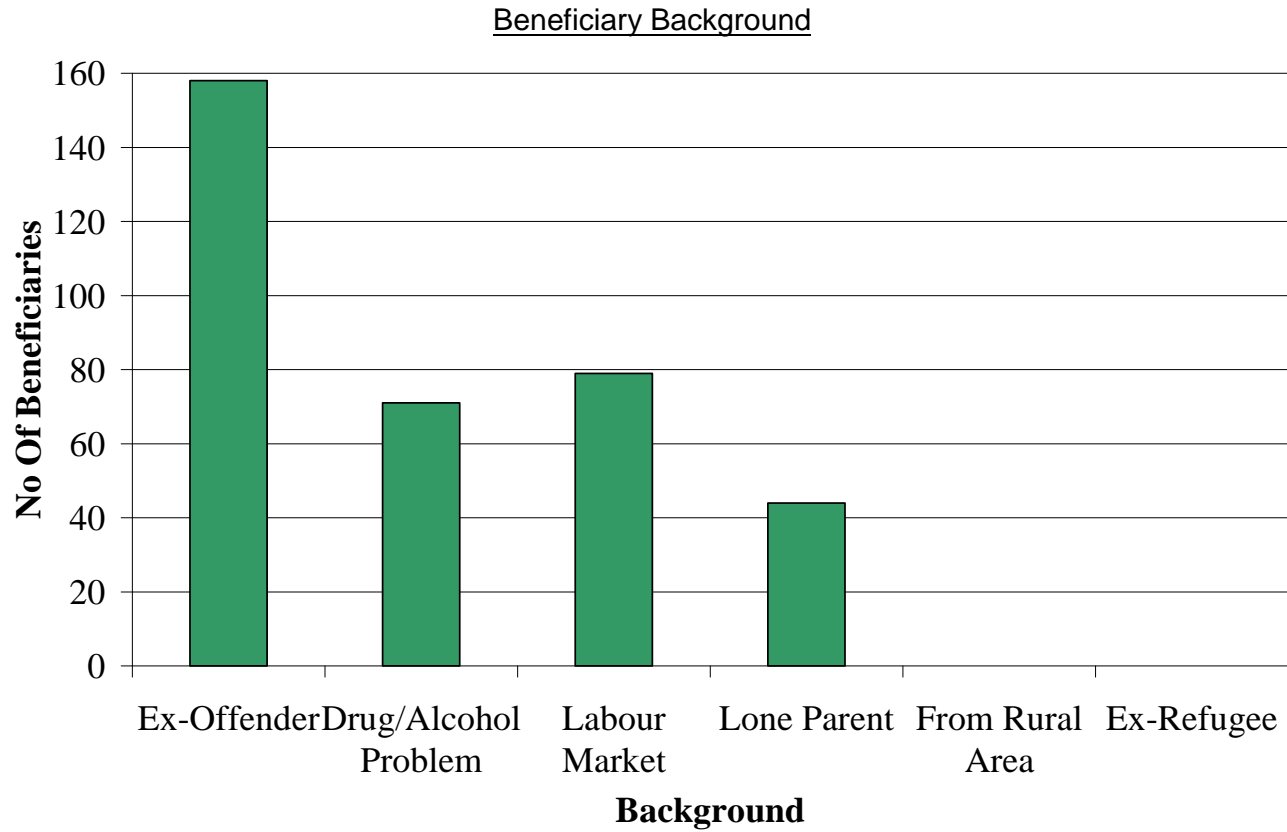
Beneficiaries Finishing in Askham Grange

- 4% (8) of the beneficiaries who started in Askham Grange were classified as being disabled.
- 4% (12) of the beneficiaries who finished in Askham Grange were classified as being disabled.

Needs of the Beneficiaries Started in Askham Grange



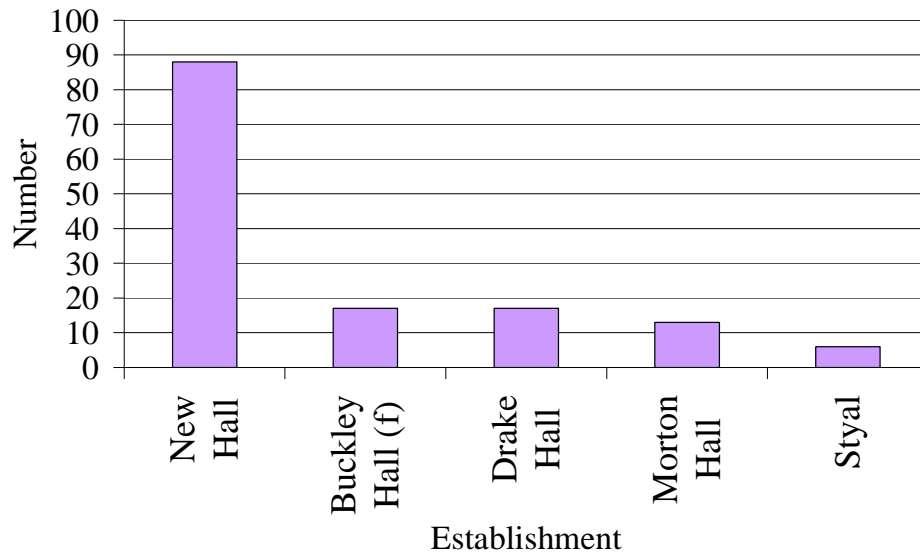
- All of the beneficiaries who started in Askham Grange needed help with employment and over 90% need help with education.
- Over 50% of the beneficiaries who started in Askham Grange needed help with relationship issues.
- Almost 50% of the beneficiaries who started in Askham Grange needed help with housing.



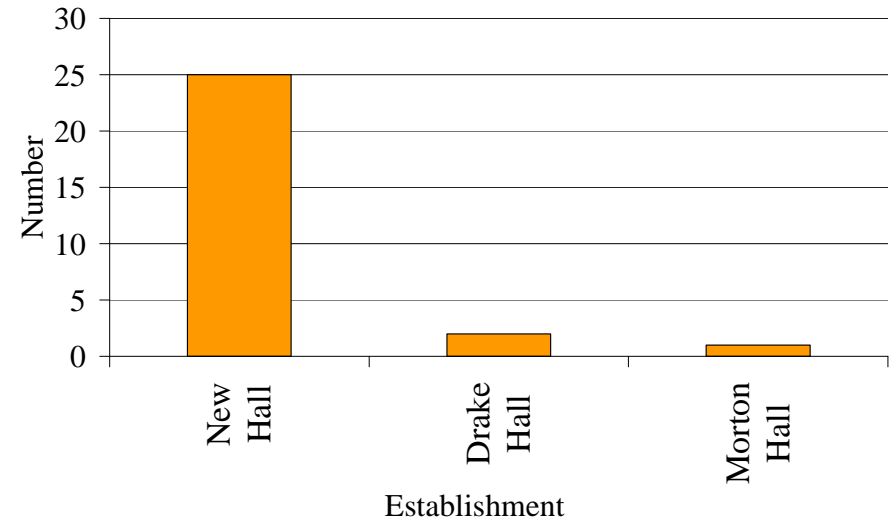
- Almost 160 of the beneficiaries who started in Askham Grange were ex-offenders.
- Over 70 of the beneficiaries who started in Askham Grange had a drug or alcohol problem.
- Over 40 of the beneficiaries who started in Askham Grange were lone parents.

Transfers into Askham Grange

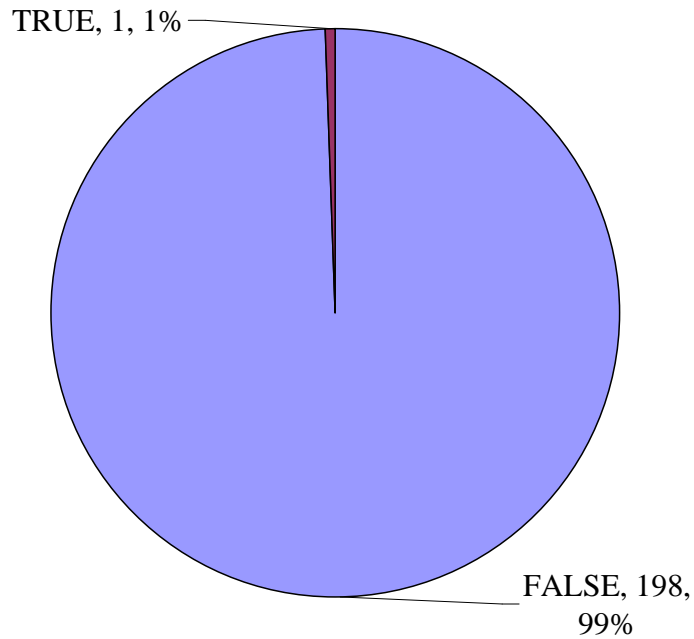


Transfers from Askham Grange

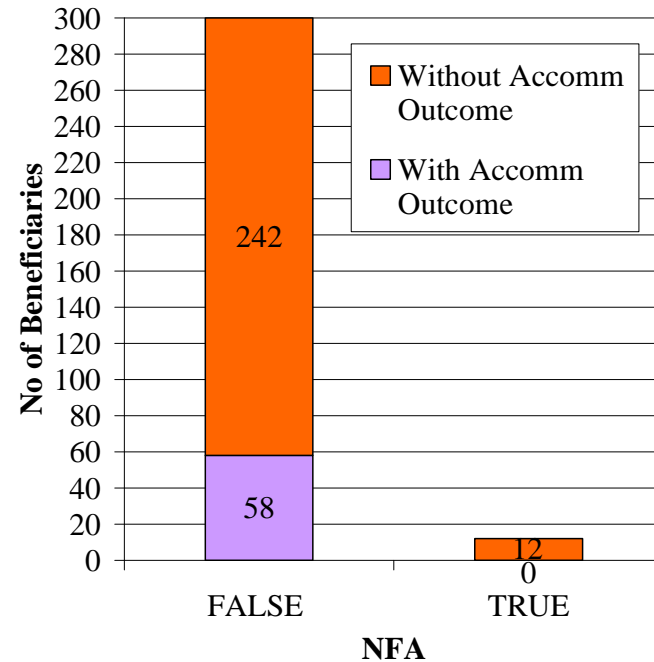


- 141 beneficiaries have transferred into Askham Grange – 62% have transferred to Askham Grange from New Hall.
- 28 beneficiaries have transferred from Askham Grange – 89% have transferred from Askham Grange to New Hall.

Beneficiaries that have No Fixed Abode

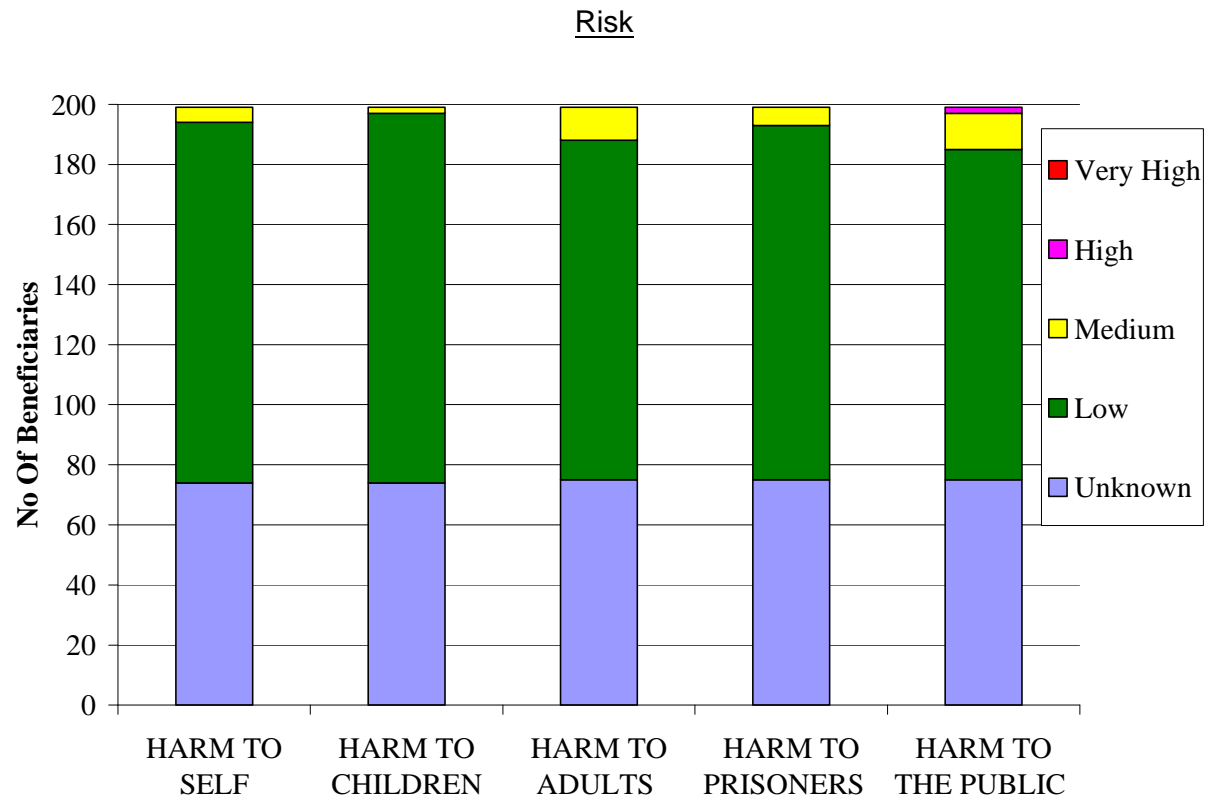


Beneficiaries Starting in Askham Grange



Beneficiaries Finishing in Askham Grange

- 1 beneficiary who started in Askham Grange was classed as having no fixed abode on starting the project.
- 12 beneficiaries were classed as having no fixed abode on finishing the project – none of whom had an accommodation outcome secured.



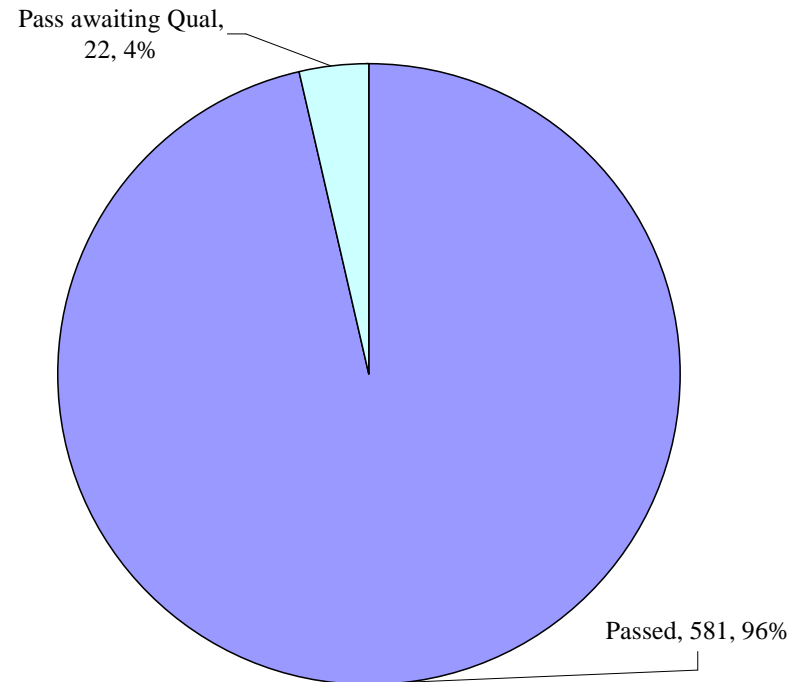
- For over 70 beneficiaries, the level of risk of harm is unknown.
- Where risk is known, the majority of the beneficiaries are low risk prisoners.

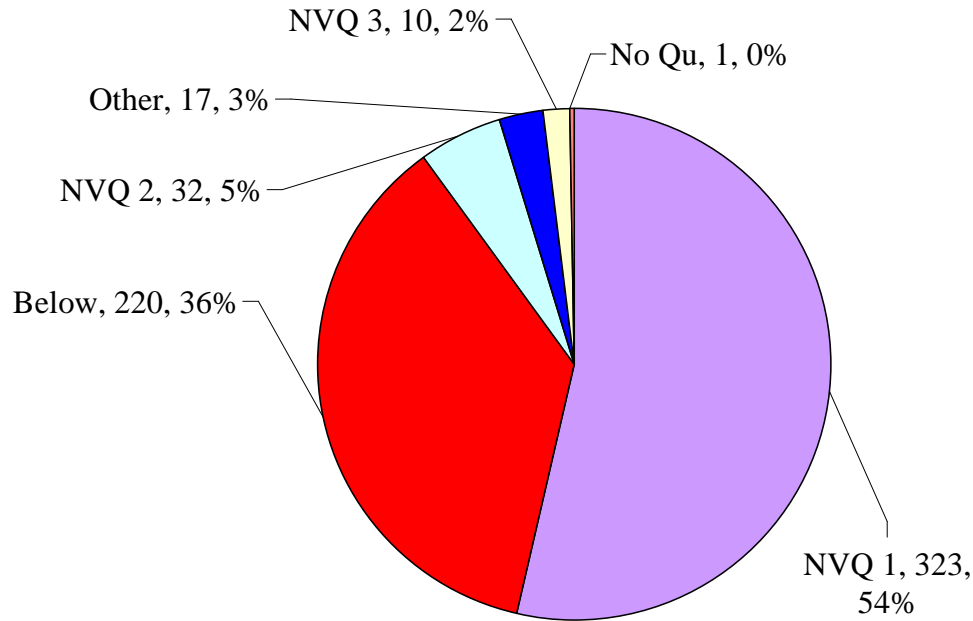
- 1096 soft outcomes were gained by Askham Grange beneficiaries.
- 130 beneficiaries gained Non-NVQ qualifications while in Prison.
- Beneficiaries in Askham Grange attended 209 interviews – Fresh Start, Job, Further Education, Progress to Work, New Deal and Homeless Interviews.

Exam Results



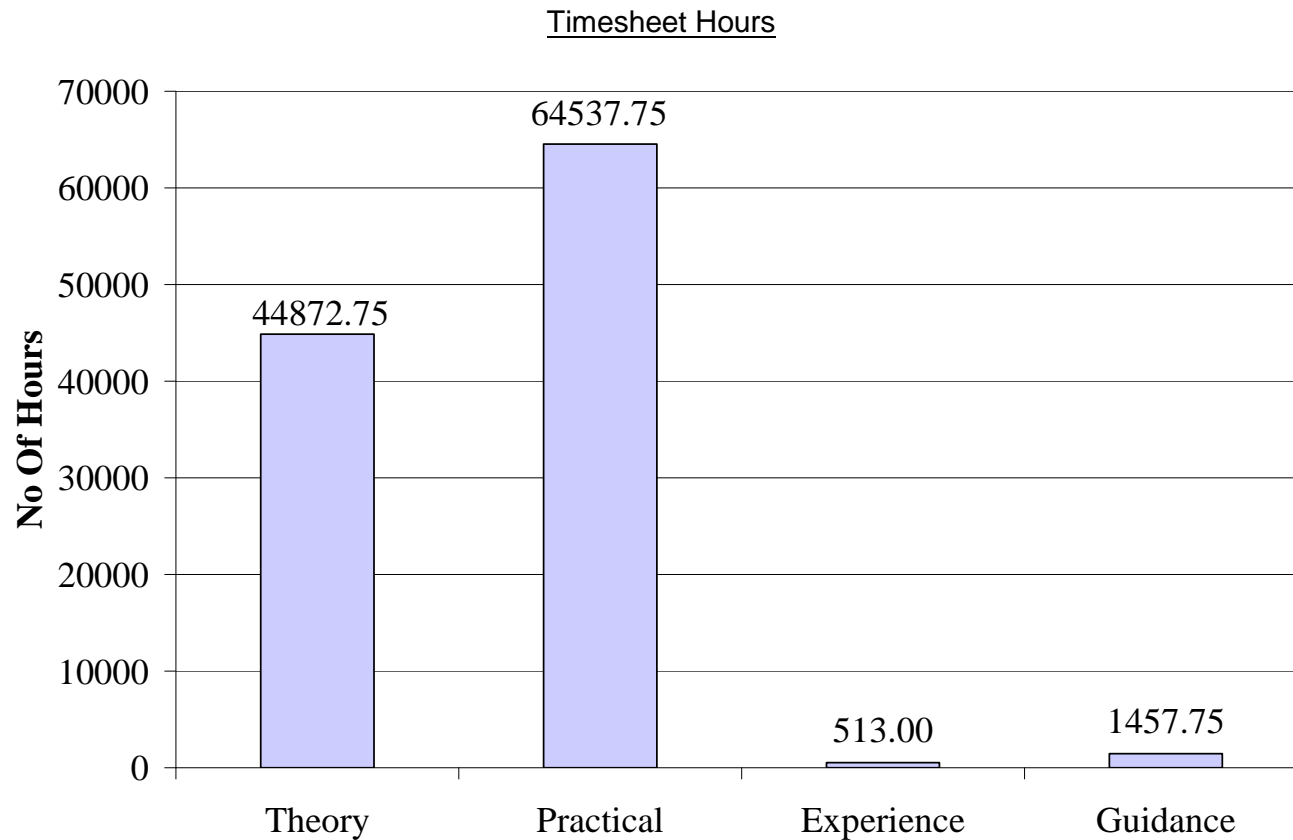
- 100% (603) of the exams taken were passed.

NVQ Equivalence for Passed Subjects



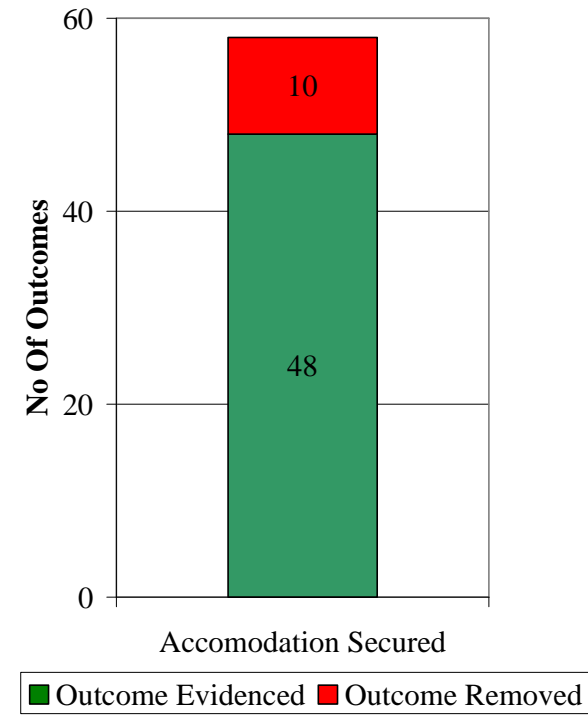
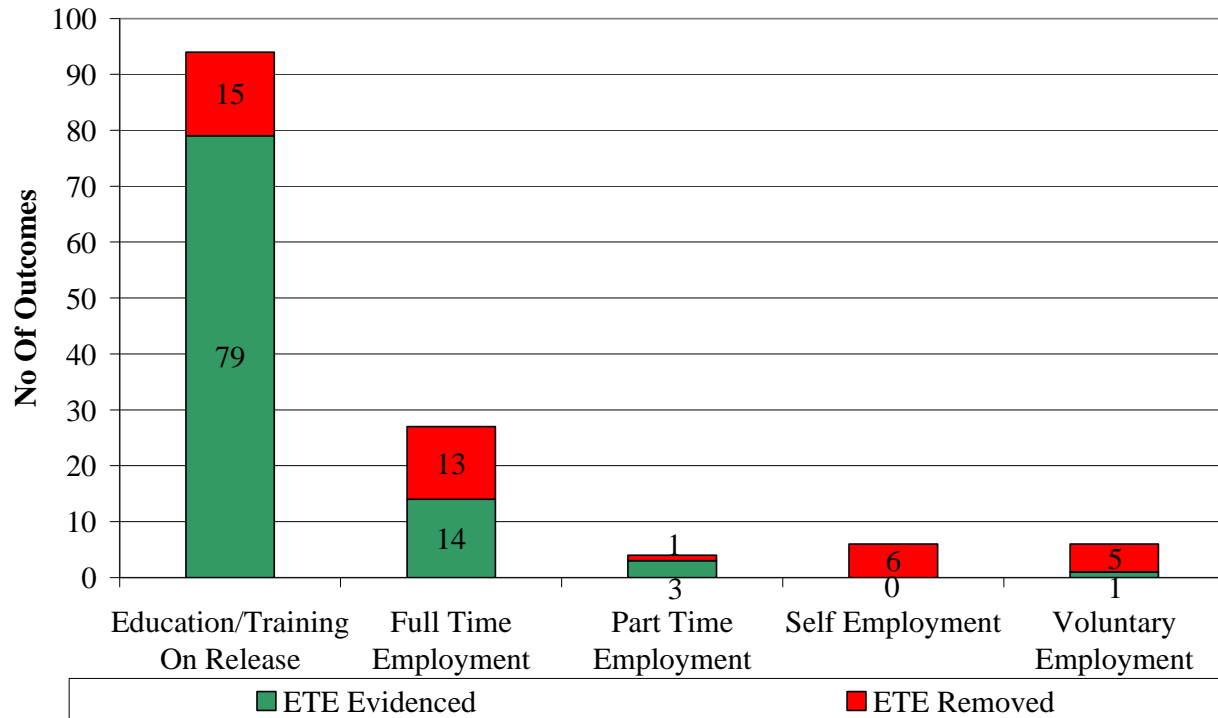

- 365 NVQ levels 1, 2 and 3 have been gained by beneficiaries in Askham Grange.
- 120 adult literacy and numeracy courses have been passed by beneficiaries in Askham Grange.



- 111,381 hours were collected from PS Plus beneficiaries.
- 64,538 (58%) hours collected were for practical activities.

Hard Outcomes



- 137 hard education, training and employment (ETE) outcomes have been recorded at Askham Grange with evidence for 97 of these outcomes (71% evidence for outcome rate).
- 58 hard accommodation outcomes have been recorded with evidence for 48 outcomes (83% evidence for outcome rate).
