

Starters, Completers and Early Leavers Per Month


- o Most months, Erlestoke 26 beneficiaries started on the PS Plus 2 project.
- Up until the last 4 months of the project, no more than 25 beneficiaries were completing the PS plus 2 project per month. During project closure, this increased to 50-80 beneficiaries per month.

Cumulative Starters, Completers and Early Leavers

- Over 500 beneficiaries were started on PS Plus 2 in Erlestoke. 0
- o 534 beneficiaries finished in Erlestoke 460 completed the project and 74 left the project early.



- o Of the 74 early leavers, 66% (48) transferred to a Non-PS Plus establishment.
- o 20% (15) of the early leavers decided not to continue on the project.
- o 4 of the early leavers did not require any assistance from PS Plus.



- \circ $\,$ Most months, less than 20 prisoners were seen and deemed unsuitable for the project.
- o In total, over 200 prisoners were not started on the PS Plus 2 project in Erlestoke.
- o 39% (81) of the prisoners not started did not require PS Plus services at that time.

- The majority of the prisoners not started on the PS Plus project were White-British (65%) and from United Kingdom (79%).
- The ethnic origin of 17% and the nationality of 13% of the prisoners not started were unknown.
- Ethnic minorities account for 18% (39 prisoners) of the prisoners not started.








Beneficiaries Started On PS Plus

- 81% (412) of the beneficiaries who started and 79% (419) of the beneficiaries who finished in Erlestoke were White-British.
- 19% (103) of the beneficiaries who started and 21% (113) of the beneficiaries who finished in Erlestoke were from ethnic minorities.

- 84% (433) of the beneficiaries started in Erlestoke stated that their Nationality is United Kingdom, British, English or Scottish.
- 84% (449) of the beneficiaries who finished in Erlestoke stated that their Nationality is United Kingdom, British, English or Scottish.
- The nationalities of 70 of the beneficiaries started in Erlestoke and 69 of the beneficiaries that finished in Erlestoke are unknown.



Age Breakdown


Dossier Number Breakdown

- The average (mean) age of the beneficiaries started in Erlestoke is 31 years and 11 months. The average (mode) age group is 21 30 years old.
- o 61% (317) of the beneficiaries are in the ESF Group 041007ES3 (male beneficiaries aged 28 and over).
- There are no beneficiaries in Erlestoke under the age of 21.


- 2% (12) of the beneficiaries who started in Erlestoke were classified as being disabled.

Needs of the Beneficiaries Started in Erlestoke


- Over 90% of the beneficiaries who started in Erlestoke needed help with employment and over 90% needed help with education.
- o Over 70% of the beneficiaries who started in Erlestoke needed help with housing issues.
- o Over 60% of the beneficiaries who started in Erlestoke needed help with drug issues.



- 173 beneficiaries have transferred from Erlestoke 84% transferred from Erlestoke to Bristol, Leyhill or Guys Marsh.



o 7% (36) of the beneficiaries started in Erlestoke were classed as having no fixed abode on starting the project.


 36 beneficiaries were classed as having no fixed abode on finishing the project. Of these, 8 had an accommodation outcome secured.

- o 5 beneficiaries utilised the Beneficiary Access Fund.



- Only 2 exams were failed.




- 49 NVQ levels 1, 2 and 3 have been gained by beneficiaries in Erlestoke.


- o 232,779 hours were collected from PS Plus beneficiaries.
