

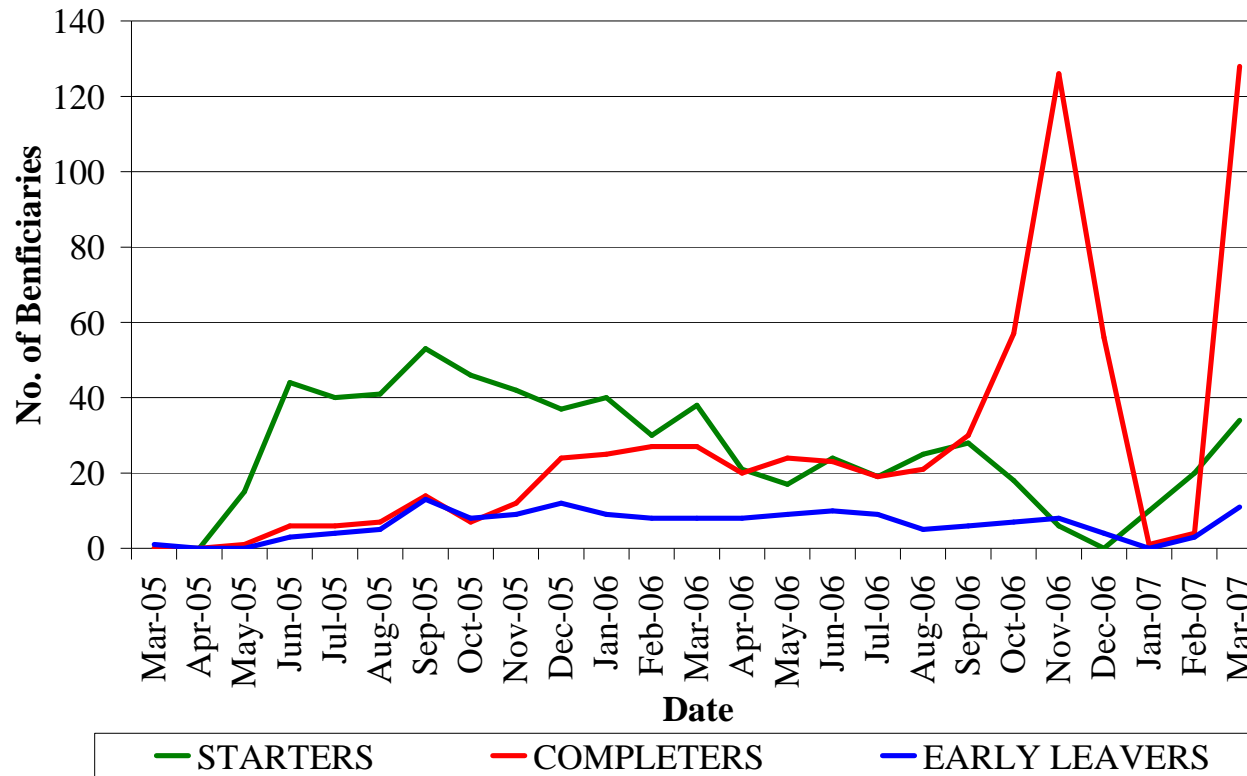

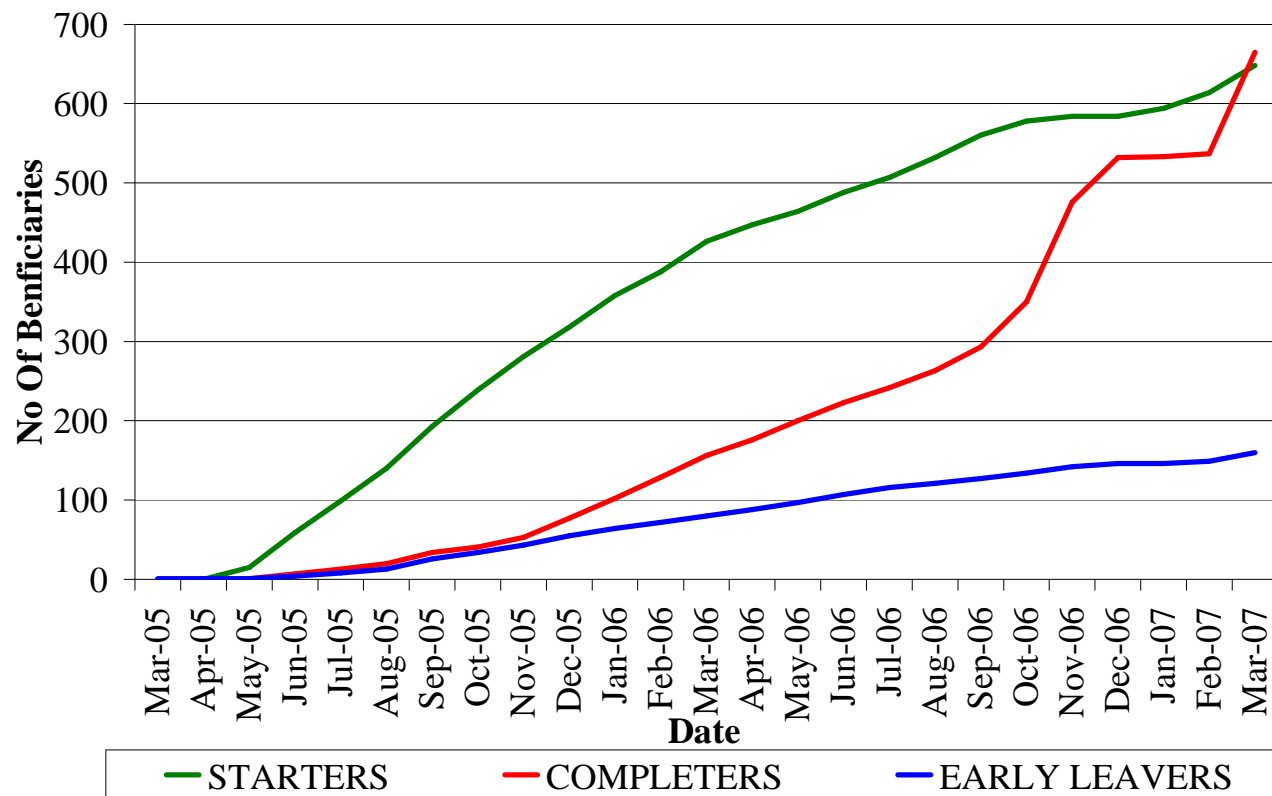

Starters, Completers and Early Leavers Per Month



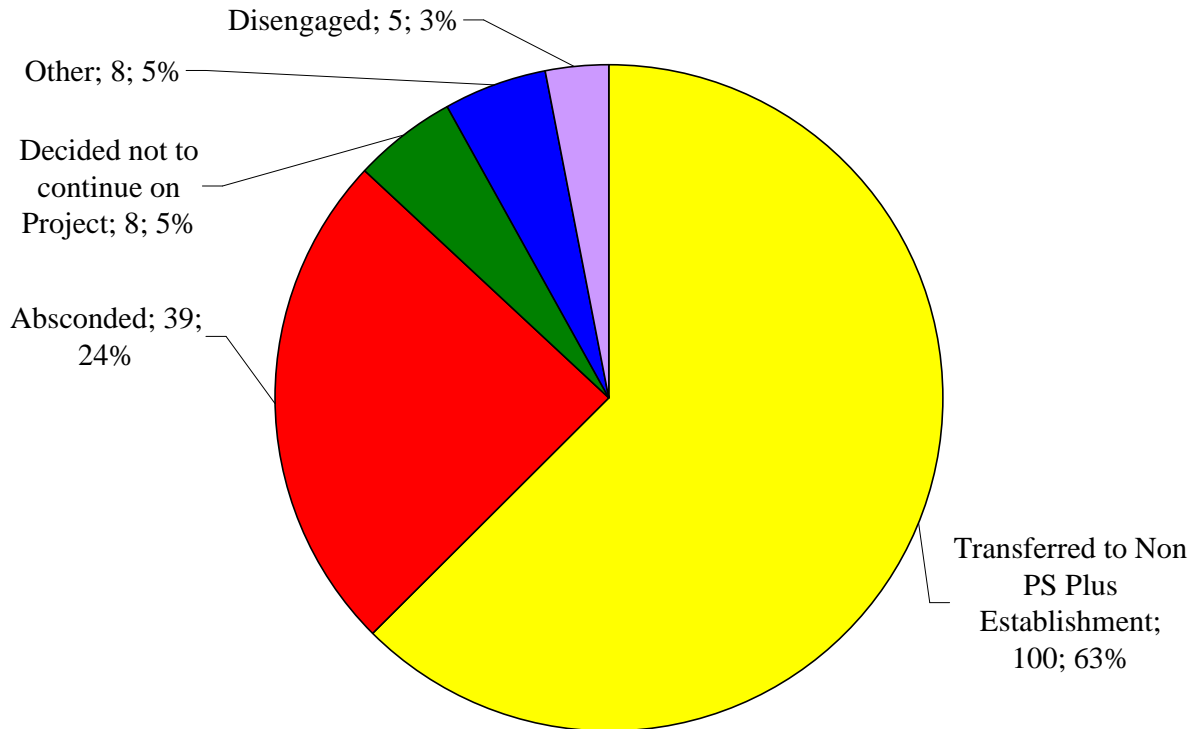
- Most months, Leyhill started between 20 and 50 beneficiaries on the PS Plus 2 project.
- Up until the last 6 months of the project (project closure), no more than 40 beneficiaries were completing the PS Plus 2 project per month.

Cumulative Starters, Completers and Early Leavers



- Nearly 650 beneficiaries were started on PS Plus 2 in Leyhill.
- Over 800 beneficiaries finished in Leyhill – 665 completed the project and 160 left the project early.

Reasons for Early Leavers

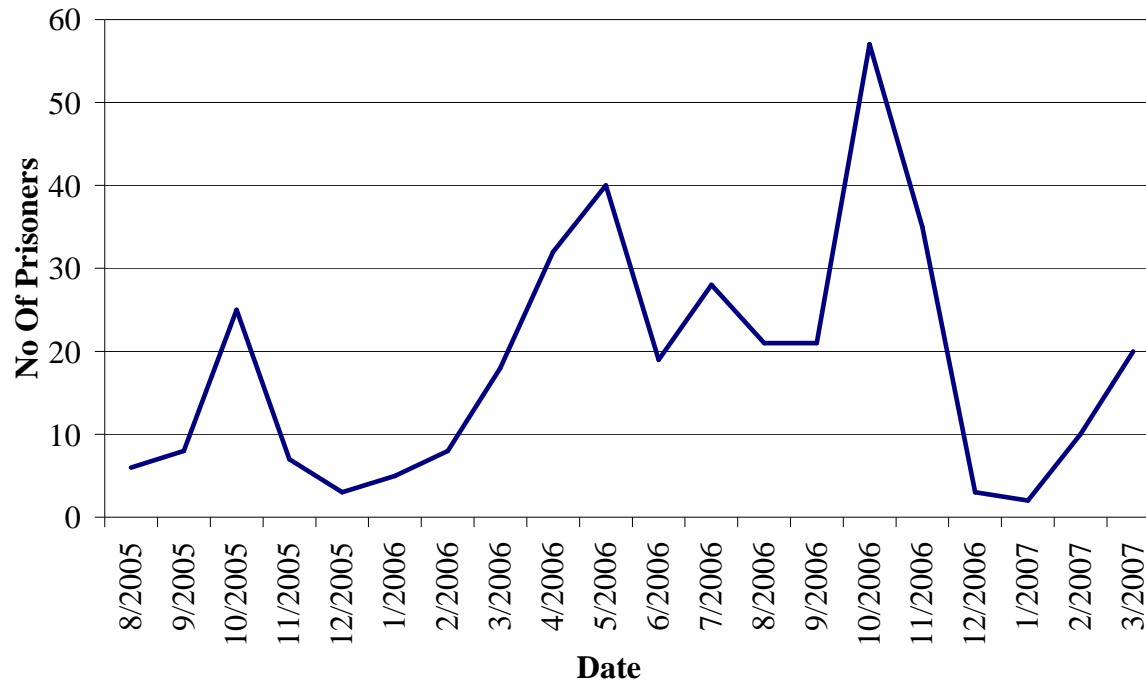

- Of the 160 beneficiaries who left the project early, 63% (100) transferred to a non-PS Plus establishment.
- 39 of the beneficiaries who were early leavers absconded.

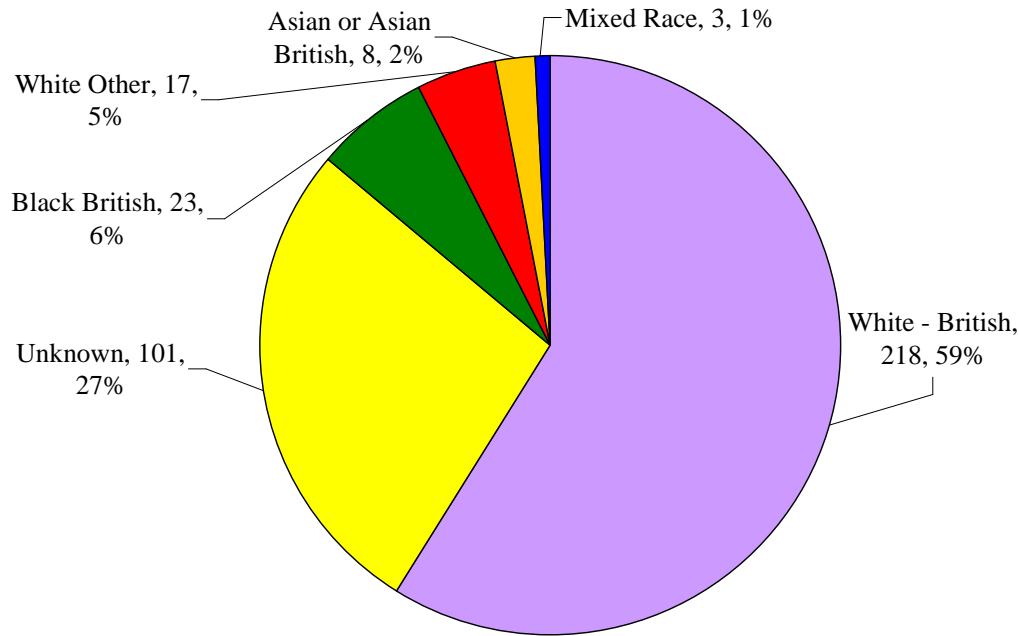

- Most months, less than 30 prisoners were seen and deemed unsuitable for the project.
- In total, 370 prisoners were not started on the PS Plus 2 project in Leyhill.
- 110 of the prisoners not started in Leyhill did not require PS Plus Services.

Ethnic Breakdown of prisoners not started



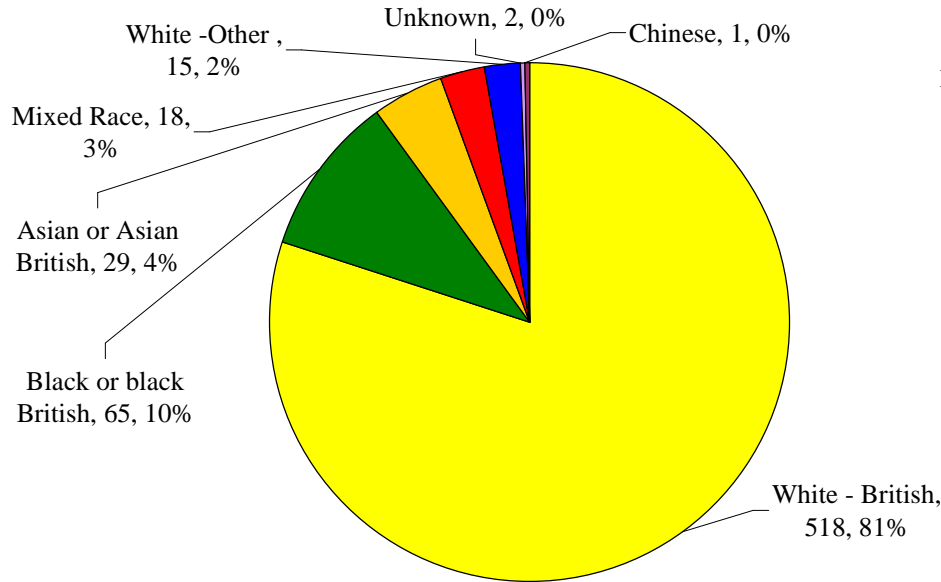

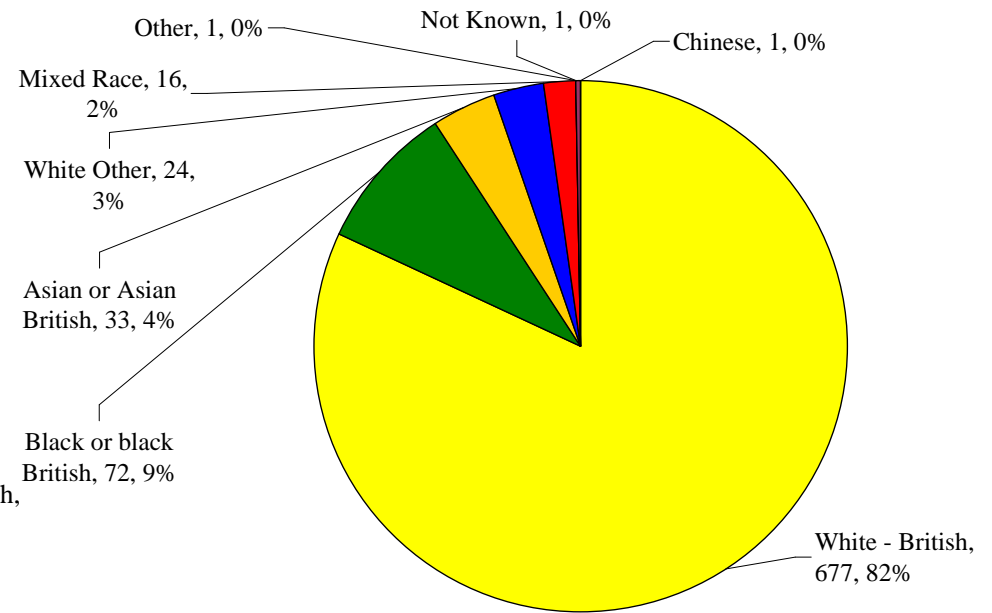
- The majority of the prisoners not started on the PS Plus project were White-British (59%) and from United Kingdom (81%).
- The ethnic origin for 2 in 7 and the nationality of 1 in 20 of the prisoners not started was unknown.
- Ethnic minorities account for 14% (51 prisoners) of the prisoners not started.

- 81% (518) of the beneficiaries started and 82% (677) of the beneficiaries who finished in Leyhill were White-British.
- 19% (128) of the beneficiaries started and 18% (146) of the beneficiaries who finished in Leyhill were from ethnic minorities.
- The Ethnic Origin of two beneficiaries who started and one beneficiary who finished in Leyhill is unknown.

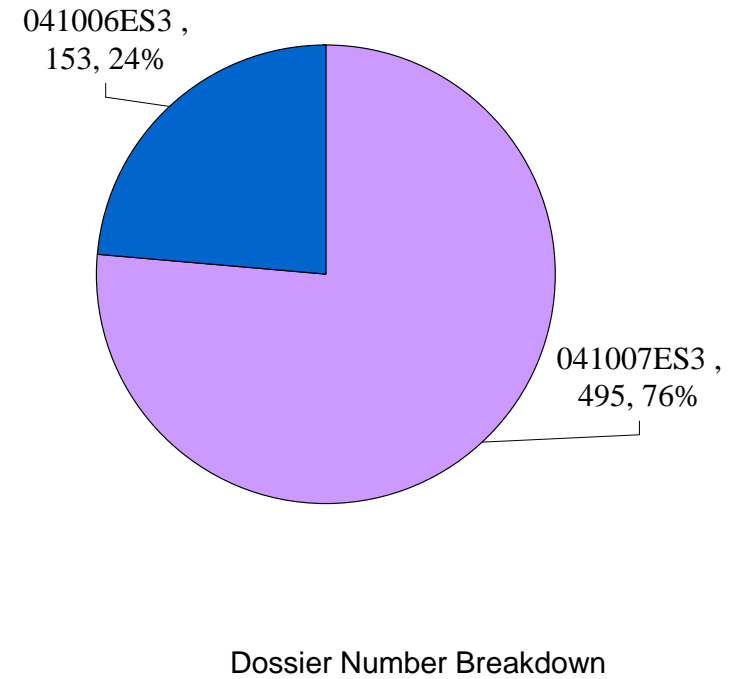
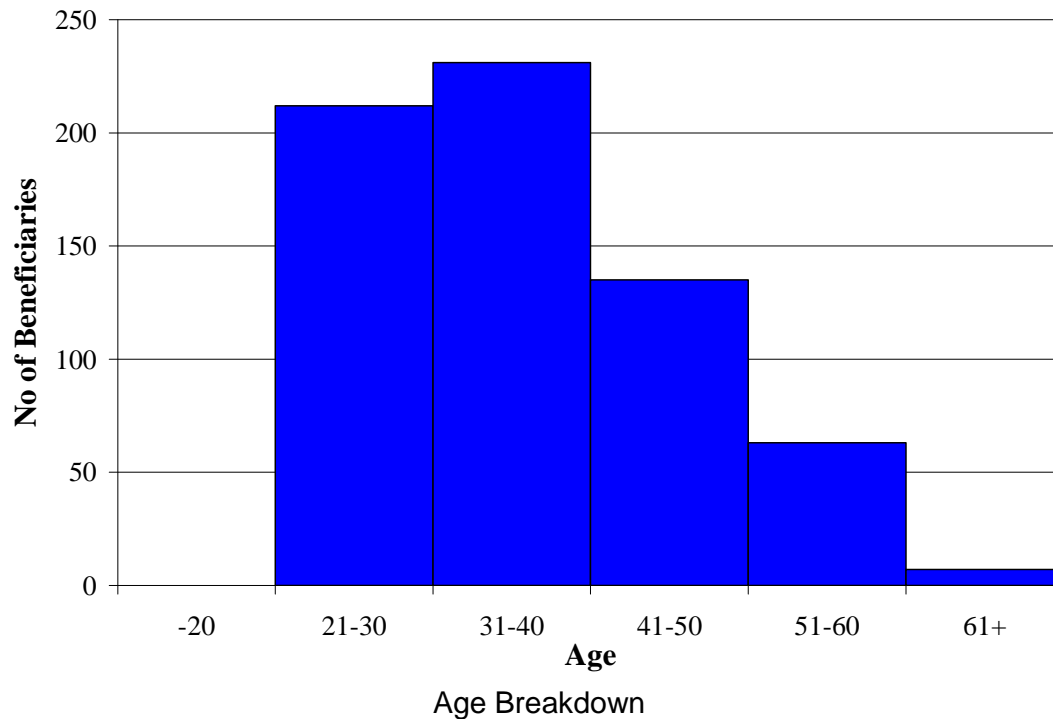

- 95% (614) of the beneficiaries who started in Leyhill stated that their nationality is United Kingdom, British, English or Welsh.
- 94% (777) of the beneficiaries who finished in Leyhill stated that their nationality is United Kingdom, British or Welsh.
- The nationality of 18 of the beneficiaries who started in Leyhill and 29 of the beneficiaries who finished in Leyhill was unknown.

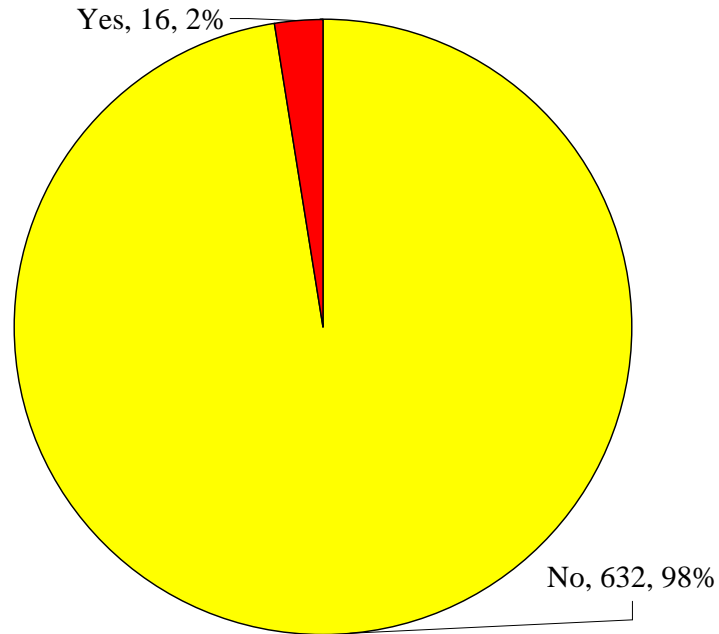


Age and Dossier Number of Beneficiaries on Starting PS Plus 2

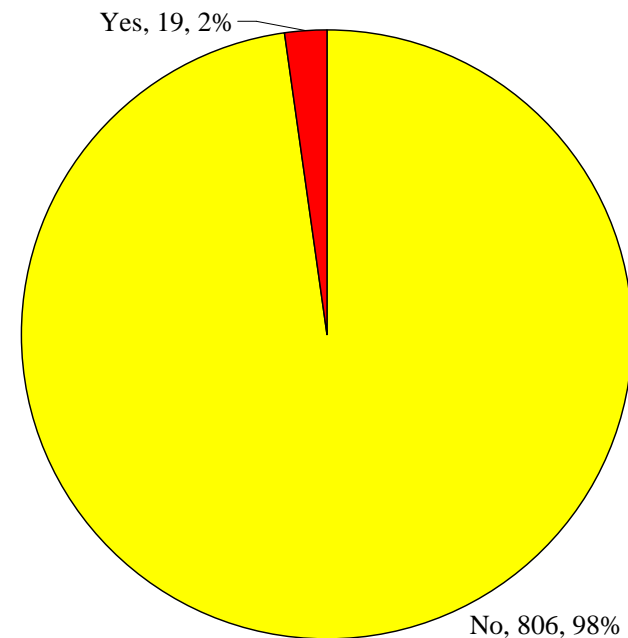


- The average (mean) age of the beneficiaries started in Leyhill is 36 years and 7 months. The average (mode) age group is 31 – 40 years old.
- 76% (495) of the beneficiaries are in the ESF Group 041007ES3 (male beneficiaries aged 28 and over).

Disabled Beneficiaries



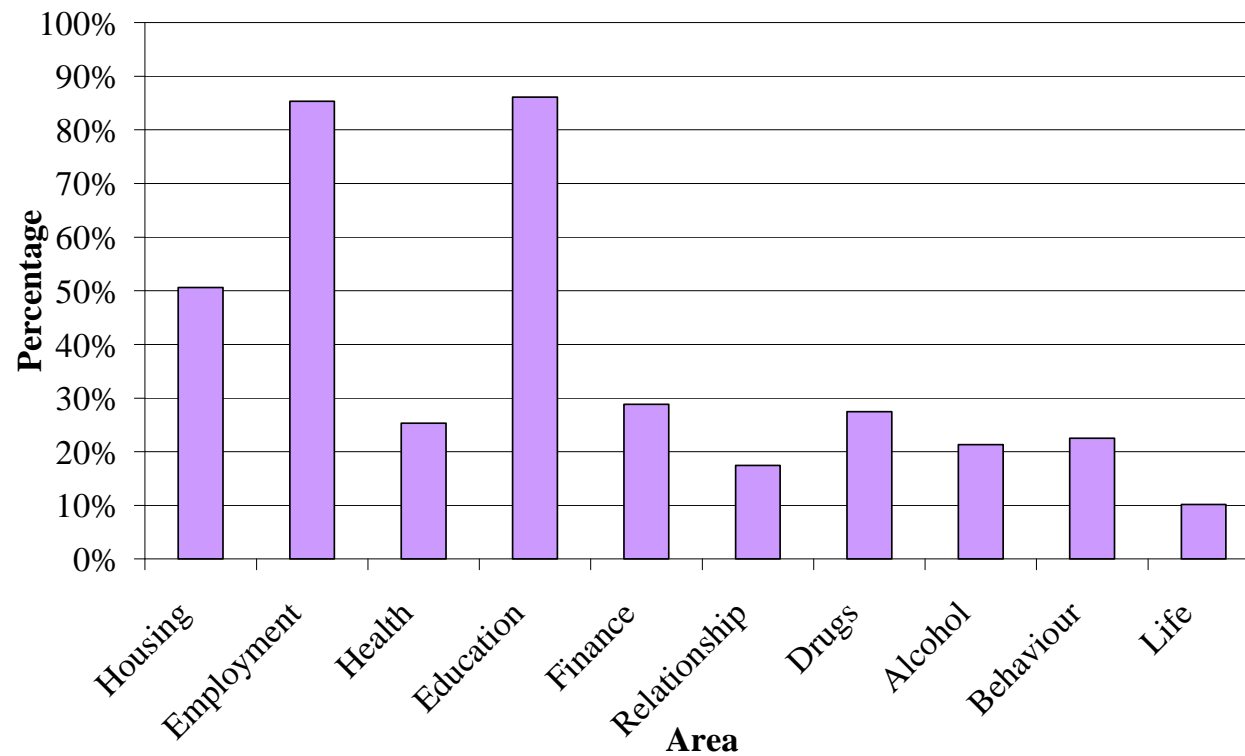
Beneficiaries Starting in Leyhill



Beneficiaries Finishing in Leyhill

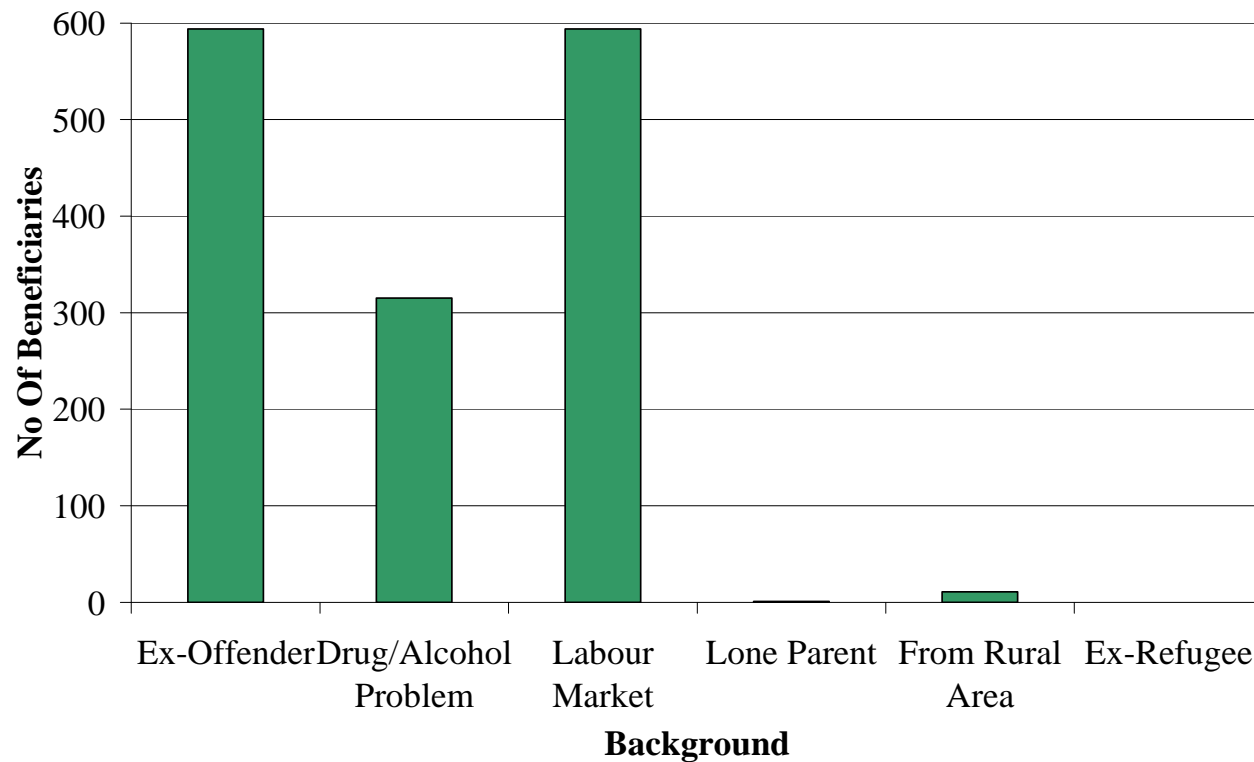
- 2% (16) of the beneficiaries who started in Leyhill were classified as being disabled.
- 2% (19) of the beneficiaries who finished in Leyhill were classified as being disabled.

Needs of the Beneficiaries Started in Leyhill



- Over 80% of the beneficiaries who started in Leyhill needed help with employment and over 80% needed help with education.
- Over 50% of the beneficiaries who started in Leyhill needed help with housing issues.

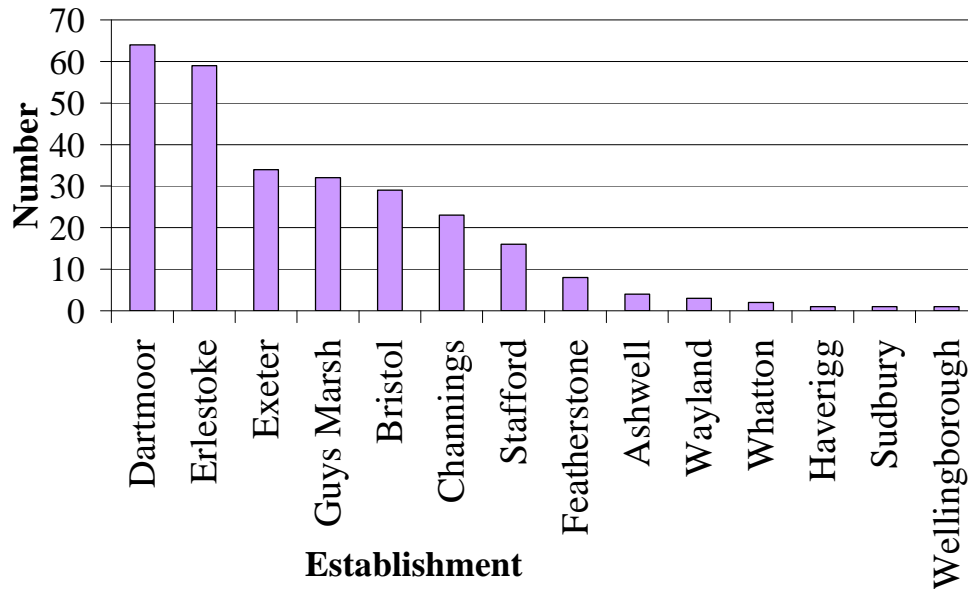
Beneficiary Background



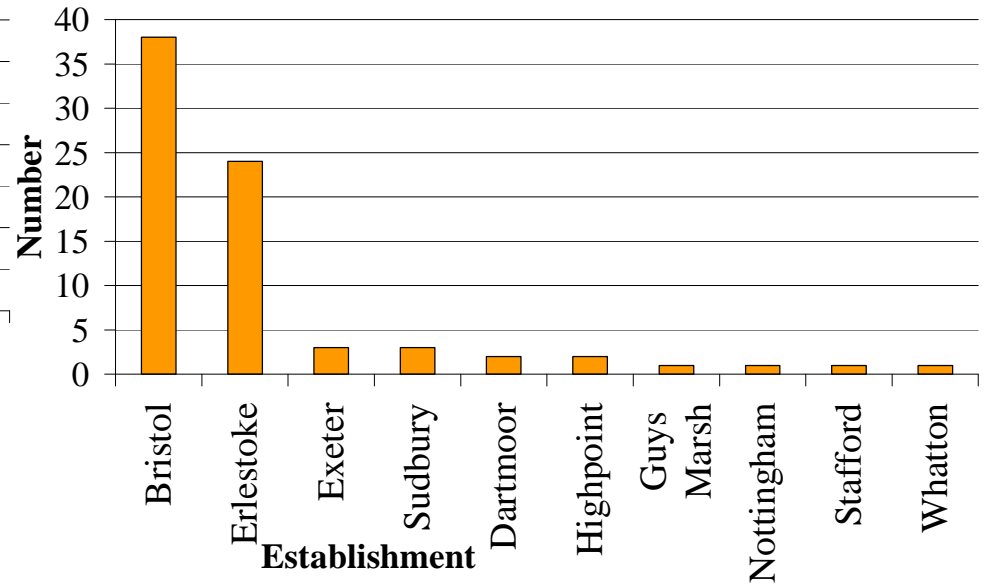
- Nearly 600 of the beneficiaries who started in Leyhill were ex-offenders and nearly 600 were on the labour market.
- Over 300 of the beneficiaries who started in Leyhill had a drug or alcohol problem.

Transfers into Leyhill

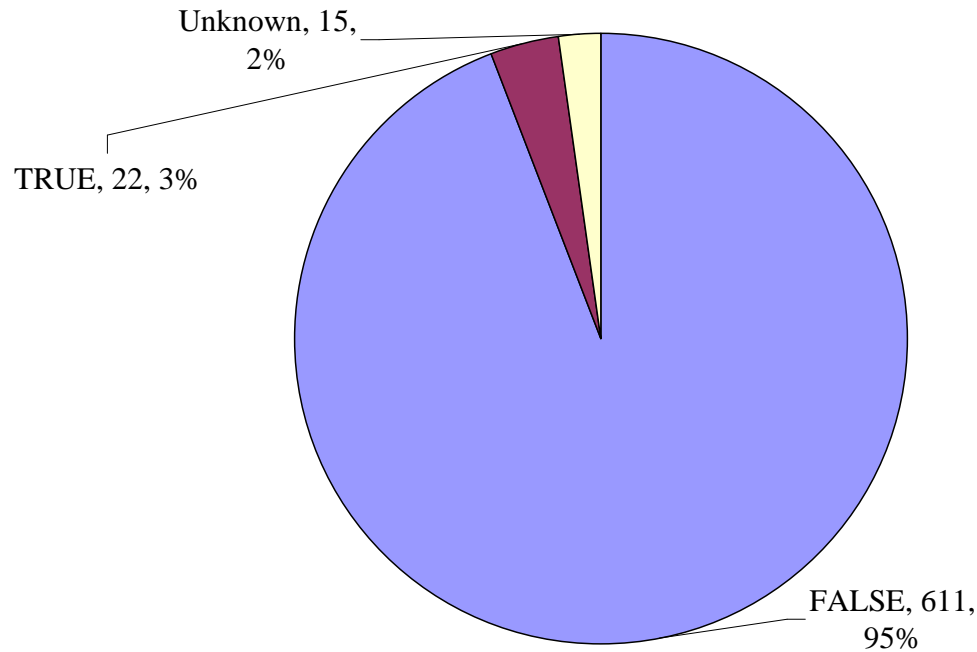


Transfers from Leyhill

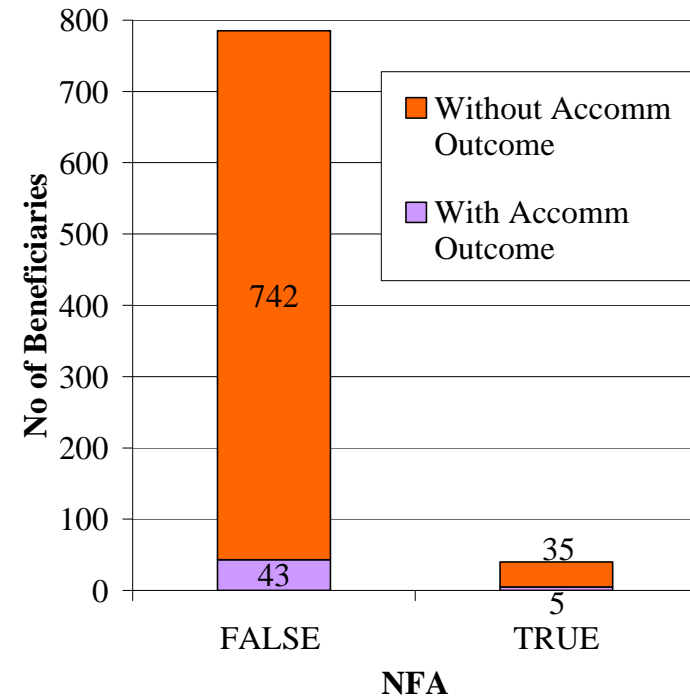


- 277 beneficiaries have transferred into Leyhill – 44% transferred to Leyhill from Dartmoor and Erlestoke.
- 76 beneficiaries have transferred from Leyhill – 82% transferred from Leyhill to Bristol and Erlestoke.

Beneficiaries that have No Fixed Abode

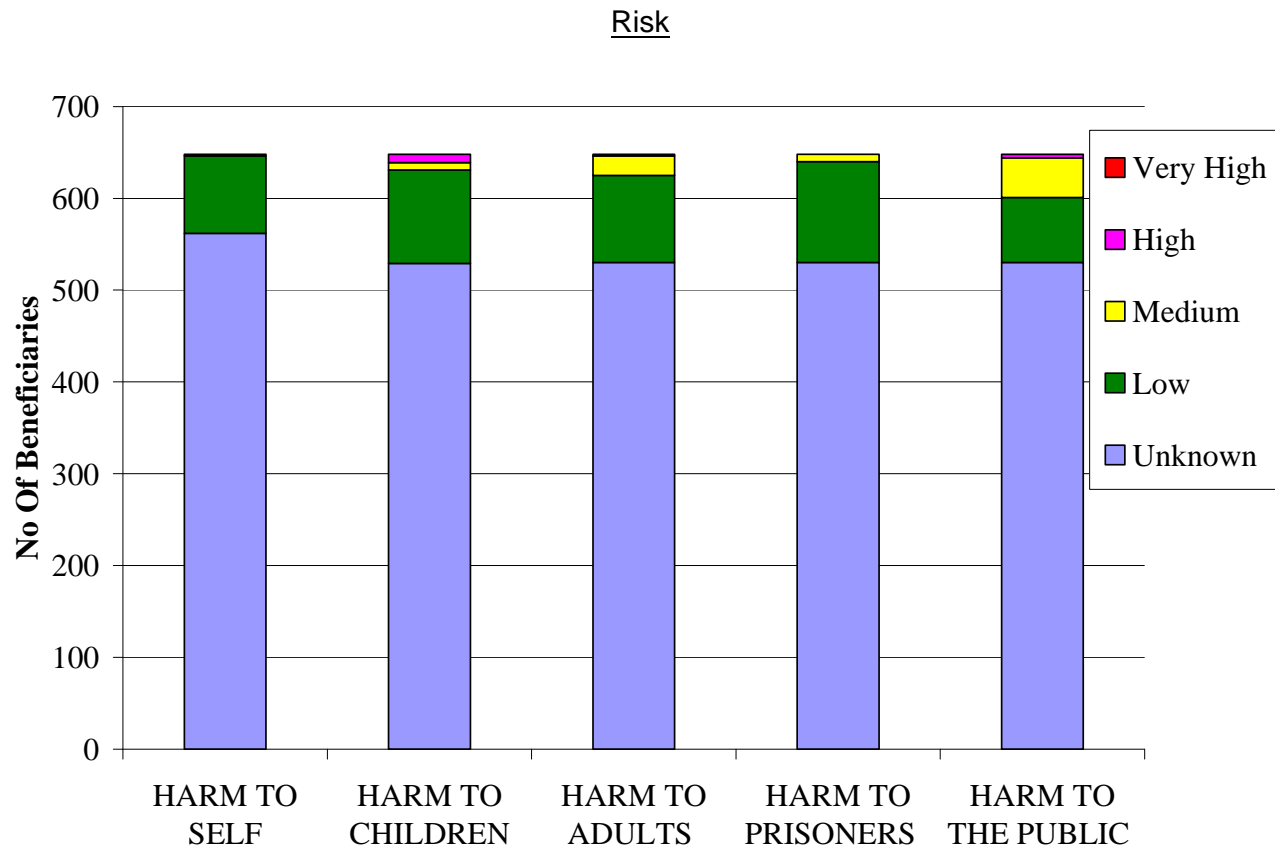


Beneficiaries Starting in Leyhill



Beneficiaries Finishing in Leyhill

- 3% (22) of the beneficiaries started in Leyhill were classed as having no fixed abode on starting the project.
- 40 beneficiaries were classed as having no fixed abode on finishing the project. Of these, 5 had an accommodation outcome secured.



- For over 500 beneficiaries, the level of risk of harm is unknown.
- Where risk is known, the majority of the beneficiaries are low risk prisoners.

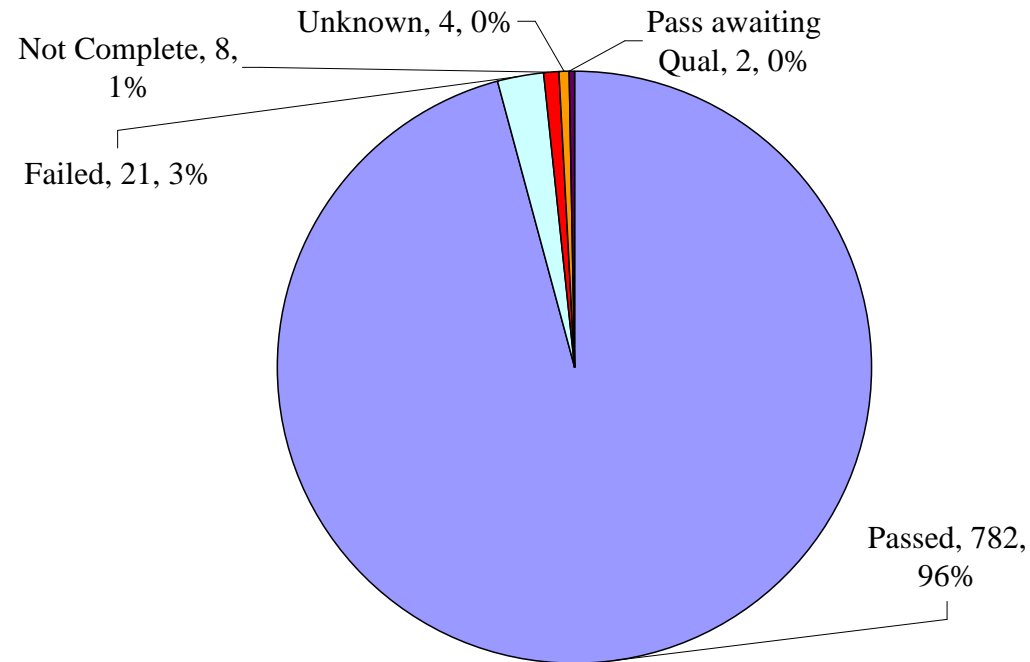

- 1083 soft outcomes were gained by Leyhill beneficiaries.
- 323 beneficiaries gained non-NVQ qualifications while in prison.
- 152 beneficiaries received IAG assistance.
- Beneficiaries in Leyhill attended 166 interviews – Further Education, Fresh Start, Homeless, New Deal and Job interviews.

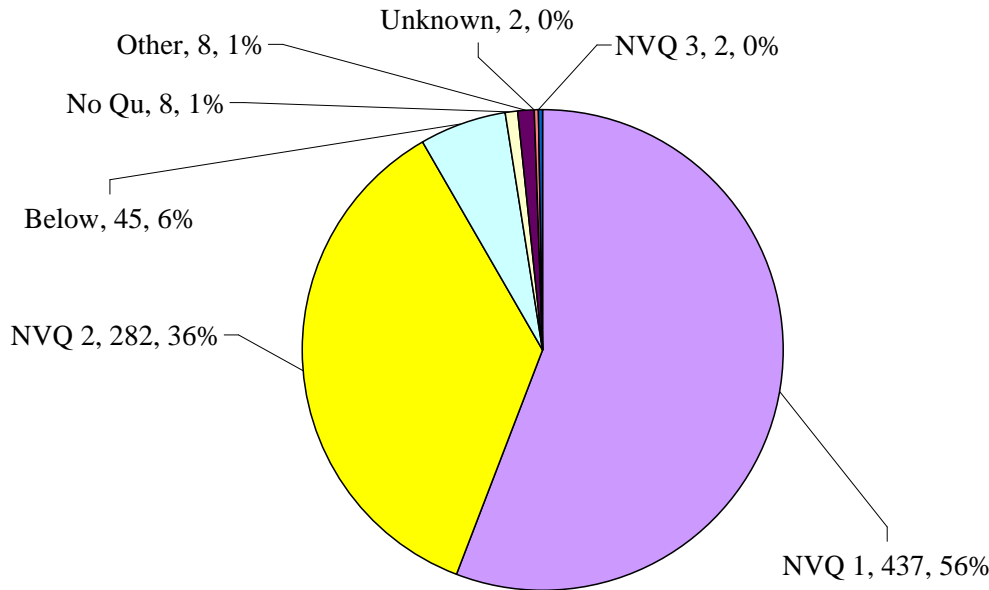


### Exam Results

- Only 3% of exams were failed.

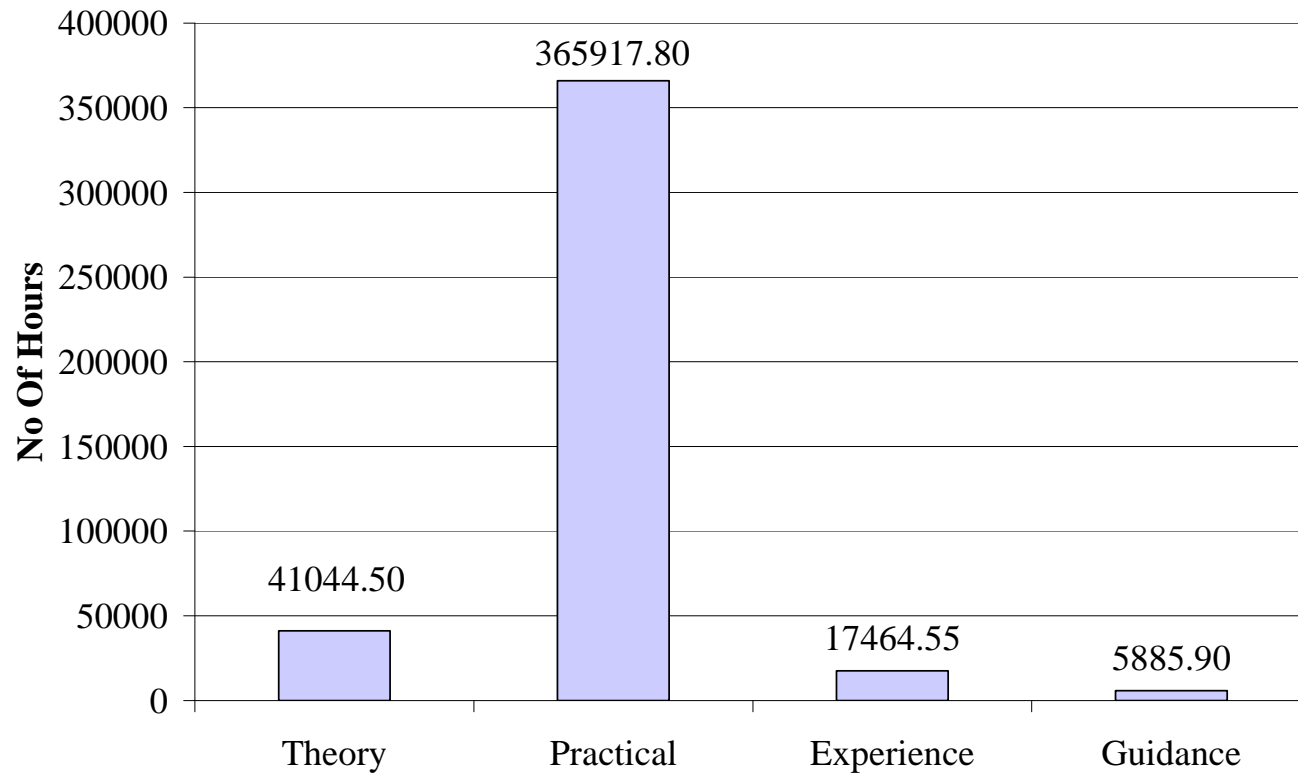

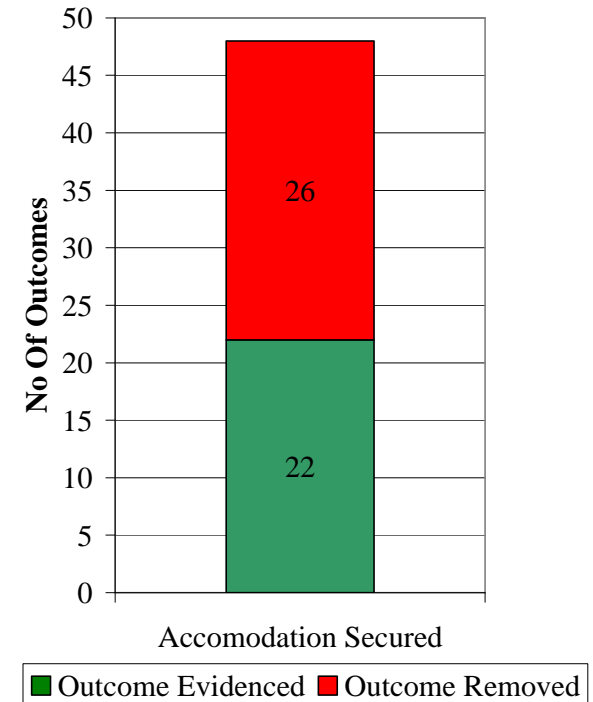
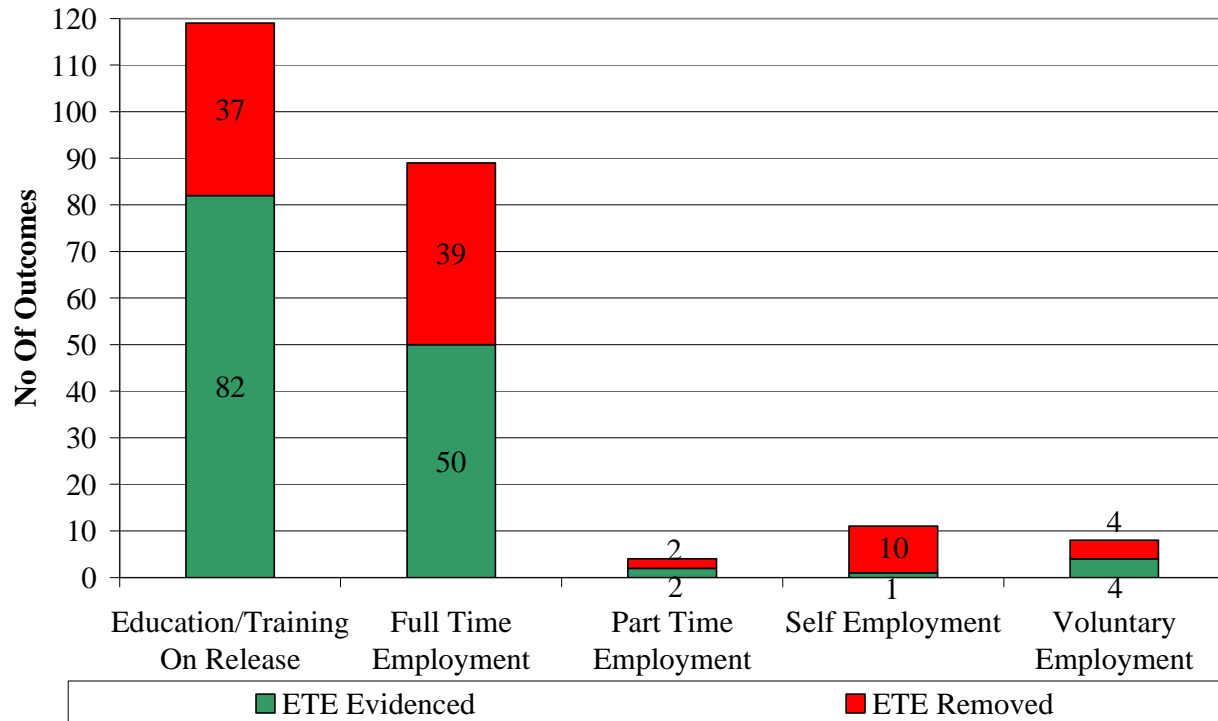
- 721 NVQ levels 1, 2 and 3 have been gained by beneficiaries in Leyhill.
- 143 adult literacy and numeracy courses have been completed.

Timesheet Hours



- 430,313 hours were collected from PS Plus beneficiaries.
- 365,918 (85%) of the hours collected were for practical activities.

Hard Outcomes



- 231 hard education, training and employment (ETE) outcomes have been recorded at Leyhill with evidence for 139 of these outcomes (60% evidence for outcome rate).
- 48 hard accommodation outcomes have been recorded with evidence for 22 outcomes (46% evidence for outcome rate).
