

Starters, Completers and Early Leavers Per Month


- o Most months, Stoke Heath started between 10 and 30 beneficiaries on the PS Plus 2 project.
- Up until the last 6 months of the project (project closure), no more than 30 beneficiaries were completing the PS Plus 2 project per month.

#### Cumulative Starters, Completers and Early Leavers


- o Nearly 650 beneficiaries were started on PS Plus 2 in Stoke Heath.
- Approximately 640 beneficiaries finished in Stoke Heath 513 completed the project and 124 left the project early.

**Reasons for Early Leavers** 

• Of the 124 beneficiaries who left the project early, 62% (78) transferred to a non-PS Plus establishment.

o 10 beneficiaries who left the project early decided not to continue on the project and two left because they absconded.



- o Most months, less than 10 prisoners were seen and deemed unsuitable for the project.
- In total, over 140 prisoners were not started on the PS Plus 2 project in Stoke Heath.
- 46 of the prisoners not started in Stoke Heath did not require PS Plus Services and 40 prisoners transferred before being started on the project (8 transferred before the assessment entered and 32 to a non-PS Plus establishment).

- The majority of the prisoners not started on the PS Plus project were White-British (51%) and from United Kingdom (71%).
- The ethnic origin for 1 in 3 and the nationality of 27% of the prisoners not started was unknown.
- Ethnic minorities account for 16% (21) of the prisoners not started.



- The nationalities of 138 of the beneficiaries who started in Stoke Heath and 134 of the beneficiaries that finished in Stoke Heath are unknown.




#### Age and Dossier Number of Beneficiaries on Starting PS Plus 2



- The average (mean) age of the beneficiaries started in Stoke Heath is 19 years and 8 months. The average (mode) age group is less than 20 years old.
- o 100% (638) of the beneficiaries are in the ESF Group 041006ES3 (male beneficiaries aged under 28).



#### Needs of the Beneficiaries Started in Stoke Heath


- o Over 90% of the beneficiaries who started in Stoke Heath needed help with employment.
- o Almost 90% of the beneficiaries who started in Stoke Heath needed help with education.
- Over 50% of the beneficiaries who started in Stoke Heath needed help with drugs issues.

- Over 350 of the beneficiaries who started in Stoke Heath were on the labour market.
- $\circ~$  Over 250 of the beneficiaries who started in Stoke Heath had drug or alcohol related problems.



### Transfers from other PS Plus Establishments




- 203 beneficiaries have transferred into Stoke Heath 73% transferred to Stoke Heath from Thorn Cross and Lancaster Farms.
- o 167 beneficiaries have transferred from Stoke Heath 67% transferred from Stoke Heath to Thorn Cross.

o 4% (24) of the beneficiaries started in Stoke Heath were classed as having no fixed abode on starting the project.


 23 beneficiaries were classed as having no fixed abode on finishing the project. Of these, 5 had an accommodation outcome secured.

- Where risk is known, the majority of the beneficiaries are low risk prisoners towards themselves, children, adults, prisoners, and medium risk towards the public.


o 1025 soft outcomes were gained by Stoke Heath beneficiaries.

- o 289 beneficiaries gained Advice on Disclosure.
- o 75 beneficiaries had assistance in writing a CV.
- Beneficiaries in Stoke Heath attended 398 interviews Further Education, Fresh Start and Job interviews.
- 59 beneficiaries gained IAG assistance.

- o 93% (109) of the exams taken were passed.
- No exams were failed.



### NVQ Equivalence for Passed Subjects




- o 75 NVQ levels 1, 2 and 3 have been gained by beneficiaries in Stoke Heath.

Hard Outcomes

- 170 hard education, training and employment (ETE) outcomes have been recorded at Stoke Heath with evidence for 112 of these outcomes (66% evidence for outcome rate).
- o 78 hard accommodation outcomes have been recorded with evidence for 56 outcomes (72% evidence for outcome rate).
