
PS Plus 3 – HMP Wayland

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
Of the 532 beneficiaries started, 19% (100) left the project early with 95% of these transferring to a non-PS Plus prison establishment.

Demographics


- 75% (339) of the beneficiaries started in Wayland were White-British. 25% (133) of the beneficiaries were from ethnic minority groups, and 19 beneficiaries were from outside the United Kingdom (where known).
- o 54% (289) of beneficiaries started in Wayland were aged between 21 and 30, with the average age on starting the project being 31 years 10 months.
- The most common offence type of beneficiaries started in Wayland was theft, burglary or robbery (35%) followed by violent offences (26%).

Age Groups











<u>Assessment</u>

- For the majority of prisoners (where known), the level of risk posed towards adults, children, other prisoners, the public and themselves is low. Less than 6% were classed as high or very high risk in each category.
- Every beneficiary required help with either employment or education. 496 (93%) beneficiaries required help with employment, while 441 (83%) required help with both employment and education.
- 313 beneficiaries were identified as requiring assistance with substance abuse, with 30% and 43% of beneficiaries requiring help with alcohol and drugs issues respectively.
- Comparison to the rest of the beneficiaries worked with in male PS Plus prisons shows that beneficiaries started at Wayland were significantly more likely to require assistance with alcohol, drugs, finance, health and housing issues. Analysis shows that beneficiaries started at Wayland were significantly less likely to require assistance with employment and life issues.
- Comparison to beneficiaries worked with in other male PS Plus prisons shows that beneficiaries in Wayland were just as motivated on starting the project.

Soft Outcomes


- o 657 soft outcomes were achieved by Wayland.
- 64% (350) of the beneficiaries worked with at Wayland achieved at least one outcome while there.
- o 298 beneficiaries received advice and guidance.
- 344 beneficiaries received assistance with employment issues.
- 256 beneficiaries received assistance with education or training issues.

Qualifications

- 20 courses or qualifications were passed by beneficiaries on the PS Plus project at Wayland.
- PS Plus beneficiaries completed courses in a wide range of subjects, from bricklaying to arts and crafts.
- 4 adult literacy and adult numeracy courses, and 2 plumbing courses were passed.


Hard Outcomes

- o 75 hard outcomes were recorded by PS Plus staff.
- o 58 hard outcomes had sufficient evidence for ESF auditing purposes.
- Beneficiaries successfully achieved 14 employment outcomes and 44 education/training outcomes while on PS Plus 3.
- Employment ranged from construction to paving, while education/training ranged from the Construction Skills Certification Scheme (CSCS) test to business studies.

Summary

 Overall, Wayland started 532 beneficiaries, achieved 58 hard ETE outcomes and 657 soft outcomes on the PS Plus 3 project.
